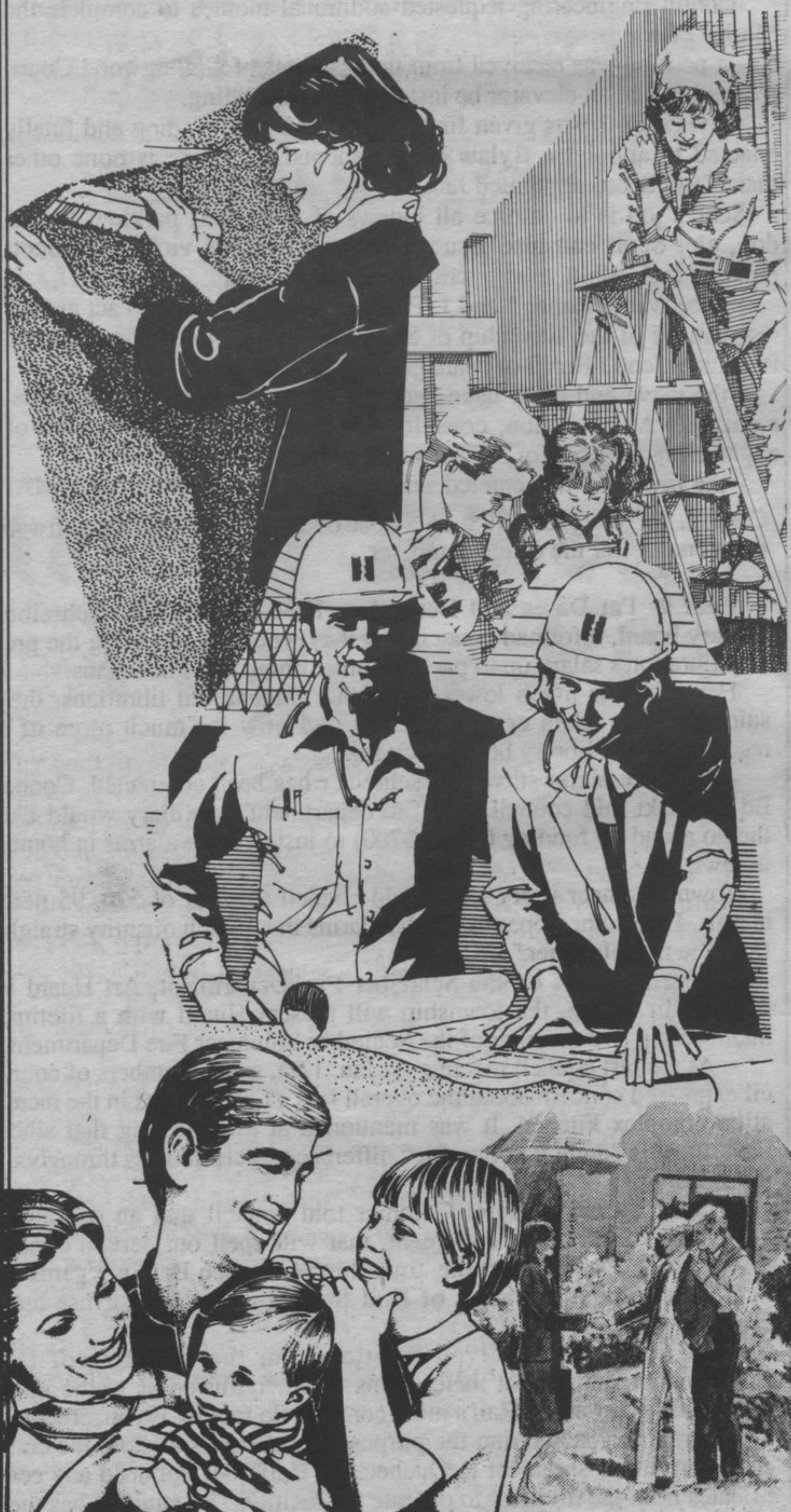


TERRACE BAY SCHREIBER NEWS SALUTES WOMEN IN BUSINESS
