## Terrace Bay

- Clerk Treasurer Dave Fulton reported that a panel discussion will be held at the Thunder Bay District Municipal League concerning Birchwood Terrace.

- Town Engineer Doug Baker was authorized to attend the Ministry of Northern Development and Mines' Northwestern Ontario Regional Geoscience Seminar on February 9th and 10th in Thunder Bay at the expense of the municipality.

- council has accepted the proposal from Terra Surveys Ltd. for preparation of base maps for the waterfront development study, in the amount of \$3,378.

- Councillor Chris Joubert will attend the N.W.O.P.R.S. professional development seminar in Thunder Bay on Feb. 19th at the expense of the municipality.
