The story stated that an economic development committee can only be established if a community has a population of 4,000 or more.

In fact, an EDC can be established in a town of any size; but if there are less than 4,000 people, there can be no government assistance.

The town council would have to fund the committee itself in this instance.

Past-president of the Aguasabon Chamber of Commerce Michael Moore told the News that the 4,000 population guideline is also under review and that it may be lowered.

If an EDC is established under the population guidelines, the government will assist in funding up to 75 per cent and the township must cover the balance.
