Slo-pitch league making a pitch for help

The apparent lack of interest in helping run the Men's Slo Pitch League has forced the executive to

hold an emergency meeting to determine its course of action.

League President Bob Wood

told the News that there was a disappointing turn out at a meeting held March 23. He said two team reps and one interested individual showed up, but the other four attending were executive members.

The league is five years old, and Wood said it is traditionally a strong league. Last year's season fielded ten teams and had 180 members signed up and ready to play ball.

Wood can only hope he hears that call again this year.

"Everyone wants to play, but few people are directly involved, and we're getting less and less support," he told the News.

He stressed that he is looking at the matter positively, but he feels that more help is needed to run all the tournaments and activities of the league.

The league is involved in a few tournaments in town, and Wood said that one or two teams go out of town to play.

Last year a team from the

league played in the OV Slo Pitch provincial championship in Niagra Falls, and Wood cites this as an example of the planning and work that goes into running the organization.

The president also said that money raised from a tourney held in May traditionally goes to a player or players who require personal financial assistance, and he is looking for help in running that event this year.

Wood also noted that the league receives sponsorship from OV, and is concerned about the continued support. He suggested the sponsorship depends on the strength of the league itself.

"The bottom line is we need more help running the league from players.

"If they like playing the game, they should help run the league," he said.

The meeting will be held on Thursday, March 31, starting at 8.00 pm at the Terrace Bay Rec Centre.
