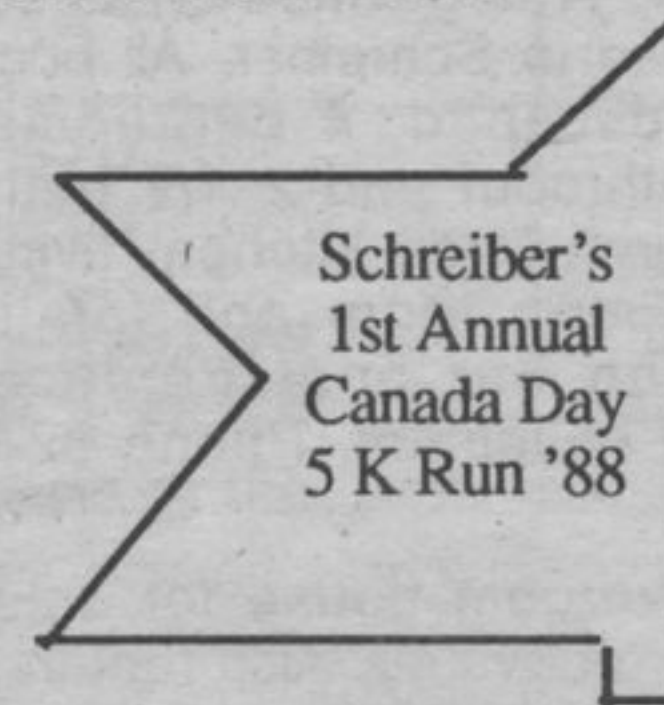
will be a TISA workshop May 29 and 30, 1988, at the Manitouwadge Community Centre. For more information, contact the recreation office at 824-2317.

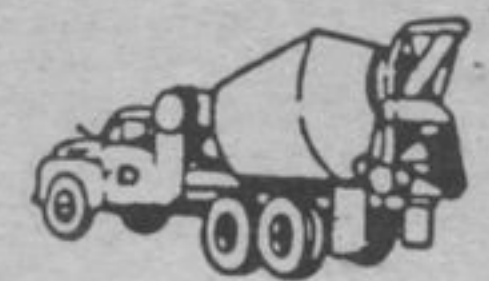

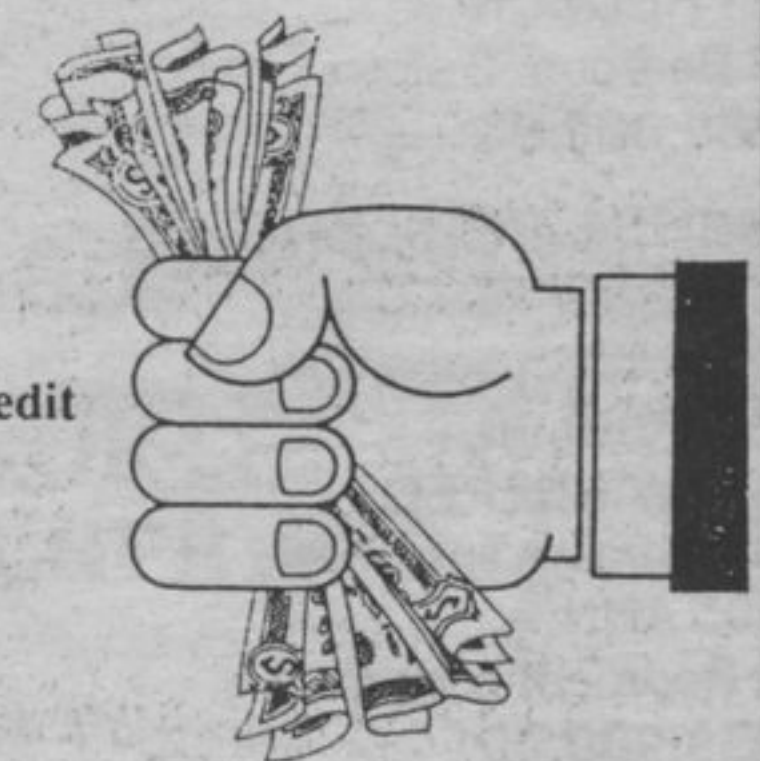
