- in 1946, electricity to cook Christmas dinner in Terrace Bay came from diesel generating units located where the Shell station is today.
- the last spike connecting the transcontinental railway was driven into the track at Noslo sixteen miles east of Schreiber.
- the town of Rosspoint was named after a man named Ross, a contractor who stayed in Rosspoint during railway construction days.
- our tourist office has street maps available of Terrace Bay for the tourists and newcomers.
- for the month of July, we had 498 visitors stop by our tourist bureau.
- 104 of these visitors spent at least 1 night in our area.
- our furthest visitor came from Berlin, Germany.
