Snow Removal Assistance Program

For the upcoming winter season, the municipality is again offering driveway clearing services to eligible families, which are defined as an individual, a couple, or a group of individuals living as a family unit.

To qualify for the program, a family must:

1. Contain at least one individual over the age of 65 years; or who is handicapped;
and
2. Not contain any person physically capable of performing the snow-removal which is to be supplied under this program;
and
3. Be the sole occupant group of the dwelling unit served by the driveway to be cleared under the program;
and
4. Have an application completed by an individual within the family unit stating that he/she/they are financially unable to make arrangements for driveway snow removal by any other means.

Driveways serving commercial properties or multiple dwellings will not be cleared under this program.
