

Figure skaters receive awards

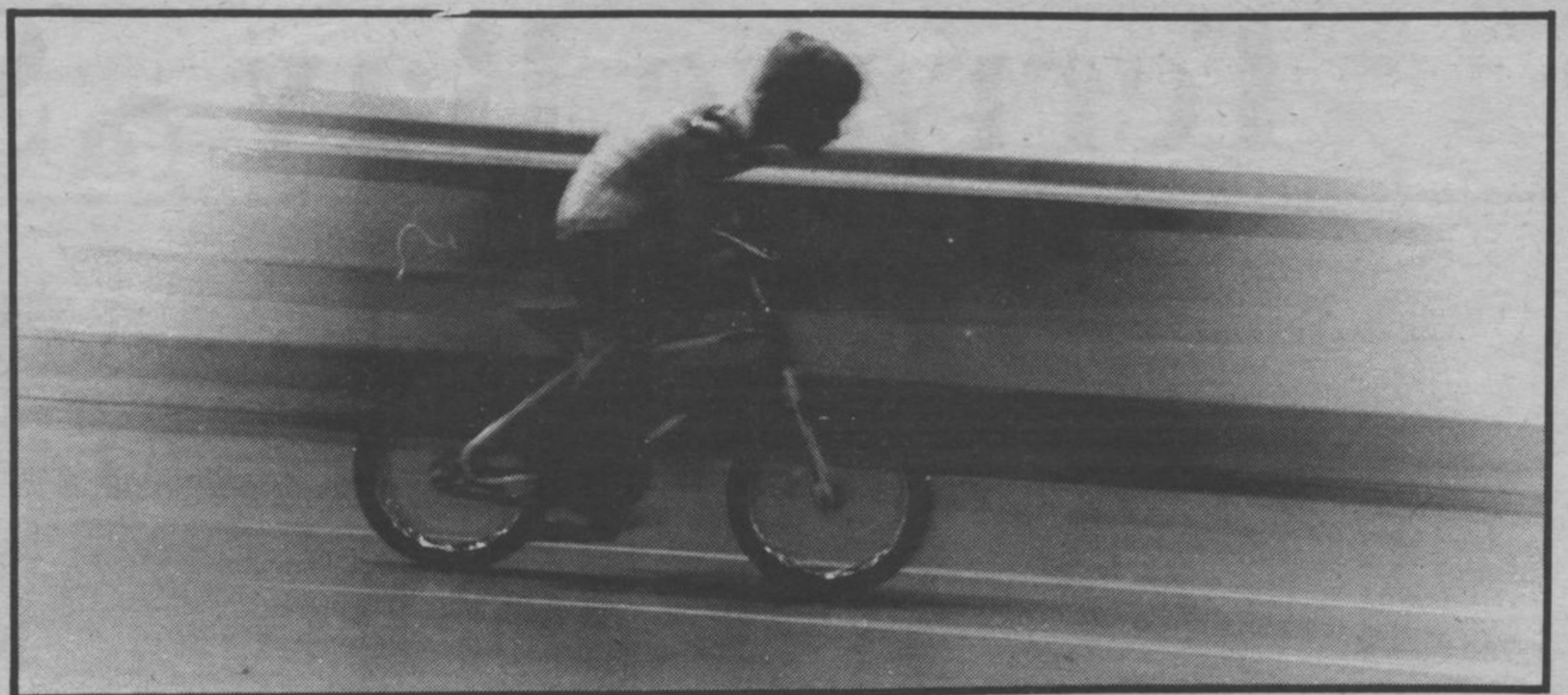

Chambers of Commerce upset with parks policy

Frustrated by the Ministry of Natural Resources' refusal to identify the impact of the new Ontario parks policy on forestry, mining and tourism, or to permit any public input prior to implementation, the Northwestern Ontario Associated Chambers of Commerce have requested the Minister of the Environment to subject the new parks policies to review under the Environmental Assessment Act.

NOACC's brief to the minister states that the new policies may have significant negative social and economic impacts on the residents and businesses of Northern

Ontario but that the MNR has not yet looked into these possible effects.

Arguing that there is no compelling or urgent reason to implement these new policies immediately, and that the policies would inevitably improve as a result of public input under the Neutral and Comprehensive Planning Process available under the Environmental Assessment Act, NOACC has asked the Minister of the Environment to declare the new parks policies a major undertaking by the MNR, and to order the implementation of the new policies to be suspended until an

environmental assessment is complete.

President Shirley McAfee-Ryan noted that there is considerable merit, in a number of the policy statements, but not necessarily on a universal basis, for all provincial parks.

She pointed out that the enforcement of the new policies without any advance notice is affecting many tourist operators and mining exploration firms who were already committed to many contracts in 1989 which now may have to be abandoned.

Criminal Court Report

Criminal Court was held at the Legion Hall in Schreiber on June 28 with Judge Ray Walneck presiding.

A trial was held for Darcy G. Bain of Rosspoint for Impaired Driving. A judgement will be handed out by Judge Walneck at August 23, 1989 court.

A Bench Warrant was issued for Kenneth Churney who failed

to appear for his charge of Fail to Provide Breath Sample.

Anthony Figliomeni of Schreiber pled guilty to a charge of Breach of Probation. He was fined \$300.00 and placed on probation for six months.

Brian LeMon and John Traynor of Schreiber pled guilty to a charge of Theft. They were each given a \$100.00 fine, placed

on probation for six months.

Kevin McLaughlin of Schreiber pled guilty to a charge of Drive While Prohibited. He was given an additional six months prohibition from driving and a fine of \$253.75.

Neil Morriseau of Pays Plat pled guilty to Dangerous Use of Firearm charge. He was given a \$500.00 fine and placed on probation for one year.

Isadore Ray pled guilty to a charge of Assault Police. He was fined \$250.00 and placed on probation for one year. During the year Ray is to abstain from alcohol.

A trial was held for Steve G. Balsor of Terrace Bay on a Terrace Bay Police Department charge of Impaired Driving and Drive Over 80 mg. Balsor was convicted of Impaired Driving, fined \$1,000 and given a two year licence suspension. Balsor was given a two year loss of driving privileges because of a previous Impaired conviction from Nova Scotia.
