Local woman jailed for drug trafficking

money which was seized from Comeau will be retained by the government.

Judge S. Kurisko sentenced Comeau to 180 days imprisonment on June 6, 1989. The investigation stemming from the 28th of November, 1988, was conducted by members of the Schreiber OPP detachment.

Police say they hope that this will be a deterrent to drug pushers and also make citizens aware of the drugs that are available in town.

Comeau was arrested for Trafficking a Narcotic on that day and found to be carrying approximately four grams of cocaine and a large sum of money totalling approximately \$3,700.

A search of the Comeau residence was carried out which also revealed other items for court use.

On March 8, 1989, a preliminary hearing was held at Schreiber's Legion Hall.

On May 8, 1989, Comeau pled guilty to a charge of Trafficking a Narcotic and on June 6, 1989, the sentence of 180 days imprisonment was handed down. The
