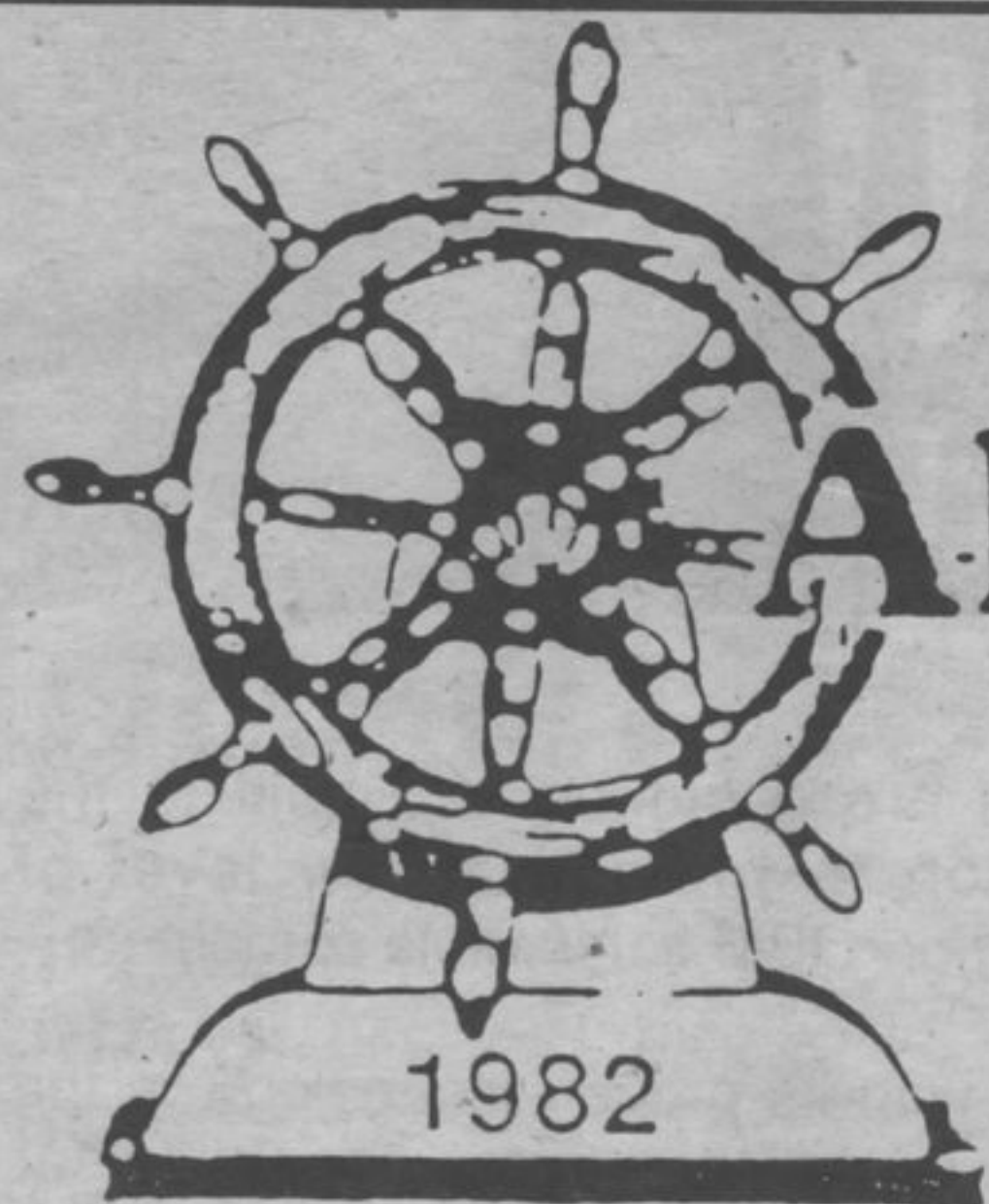
Swimming Lessons

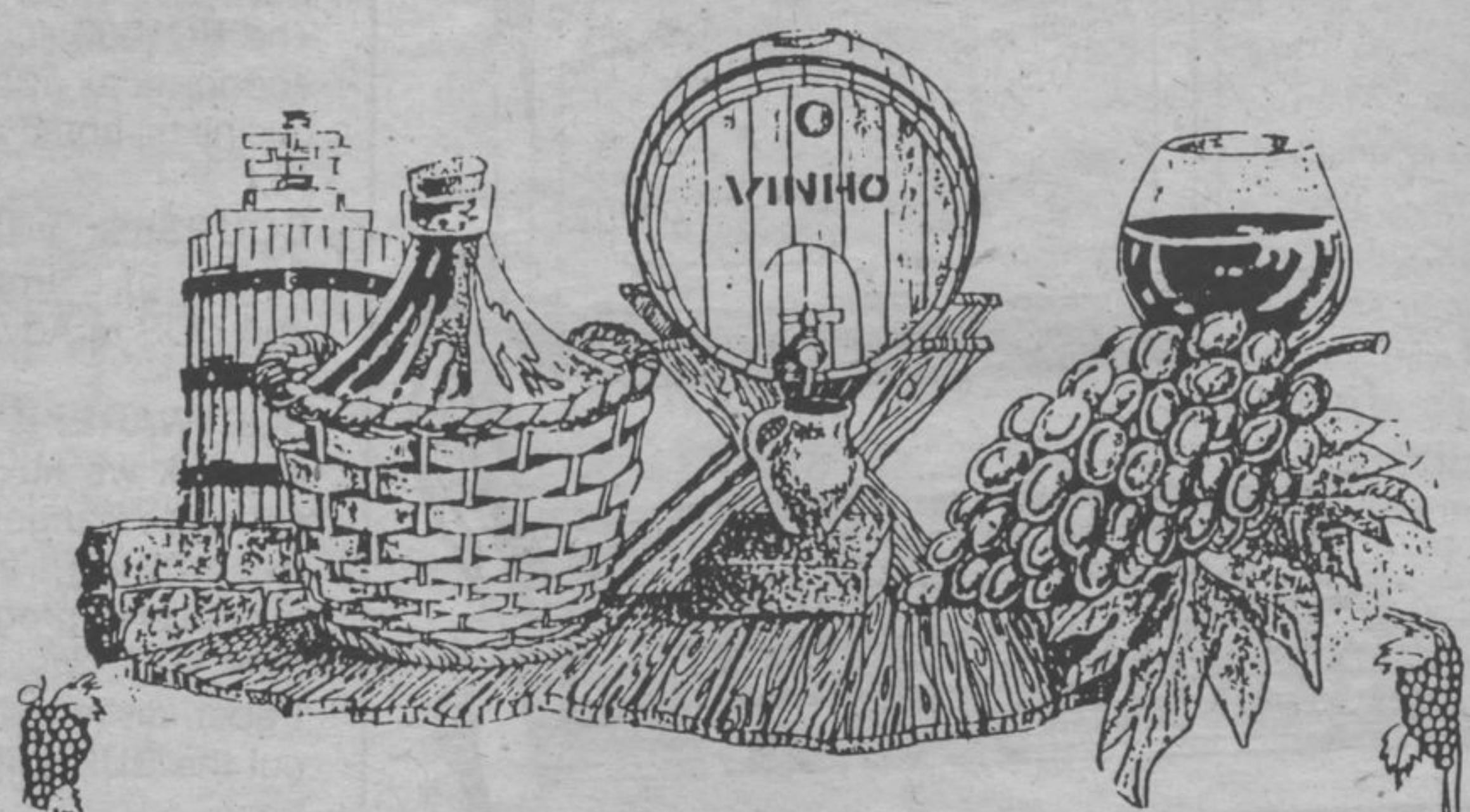
