On October 3, 1946, a branch of the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce opened in Terrace Bay.

On February 1, 1947 our Post

Office opened.

On October 22, 1947, the last pulp logs went over the Aguasabon Falls.

On January 8, 1948, the Boiler House steam whistle was blown for the first time.

On July 8, 1948, the gates were closed at the Hydro Dam, to create Hays Lake.

On June 25, 1949, the Masonic Lodge was instituted.

On September 15, 1950, the Moose Lodge was dedicated and officers were installed.

In 1964 the first tree length wood was delivered to the Terrace Bay mill yard.

On February 10, 1966, the first Terrace Bay Festival was held.

On September 8, 1966 the first Fall Fair was held. It included displays, races and a visit from Miss Canada.

In 1969 the Ministry of Natural Resources offices opened in Terrace Bay.

In July of 1975 construction on the mill expansion began.

In July, 1977 the mill expansion was completed.


