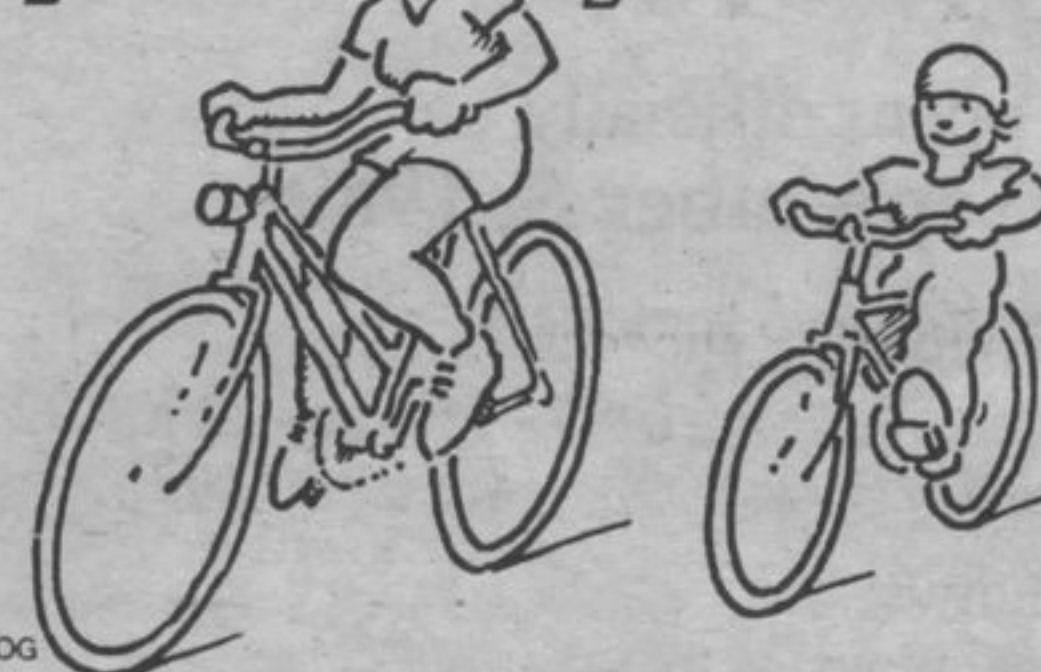

School Safety

Ability



This sign is erected at places where children cross to and from school. Take extra care - watch for children. Obey the maximum speed limit indicated on the sign if applicable.

Your school bus operator asks you to sign this safety pledge.

- 1 I promise to be at the bus stop on time. I will not stand or play on the road while waiting for the bus.
- 2 I promise to stand in line when getting on the bus. I will always use the handrail.
- 3 I promise to go to my seat promptly, and stay in it until it is time for me to leave the bus. If I must stand up, I will hold on tightly.
- 4 I promise that I will not throw things in the bus or out of the window.
- 5 I promise to ask the bus driver's permission before opening a window. I will not put my head or arms out of the window.
- 6 I promise to be quiet when I am on the school bus. I will be especially quiet at railway crossings.
- 7 I promise to keep my feet, my books and other things out of the aisle.
- 8 I promise to be very careful when I leave the bus. If I must cross the road, I will walk ten feet in front of the bus so the driver can see me. I will look both ways for cars before crossing. If there are school bus safety patrols, I will obey them.
