danger of walking along the highway, feels the third condition is met as well.

At the last LSBE meeting the Keatings attempted to have their request tabled but, because no trustee would agree to have the motion tabled their request was denied.

She believes bussing is not a convenience and apparently many local residents agree. At the board meeting, the Keatings presented petitions with well over 200 signatures but Billie Jo said these had no effect at all on the board.

Neither did a letter from Lake Nipigon MPP Gilles Pouliot. He wrote "Prior tow annexation of outlying area by your board a good case could be made for denial of bussing of children from this area. Now that all residents under the jurisdiction of the LSBE are assessed and required to contribute to the cost of education and bussing, it would appear that in the interest of fairness this essential service should be provided on an equitable basis."

And although a representative of the Minister of Education said he fully supported the Keatings' request, he said the final decision is the board's.

Bill Keating said they plan to pursue the matter, possibly turning it into a political issue. He

said their next step may be to contact the ombudsman and possibly a lawyer.


Billie Jo said the children are using the bus under protest and added, "I can't believe we're fighting this battle. It's one that shouldn't have to be fought."

Free Foot Care Clinic






