McCausland Hospital will receive a \$25,000 provincial grant to set-up the Lifeline Emergency Response system. Northern Development and Mines Minister Rene Fontaine has announced.

"This system reduces the fear of isolation for the elderly, allows more seniors to stay home rather than moving into a facility," said Fontaine.

Lifeline provides each participant with a personal device in the form of a pendant. At the push of a button, a friend, relative or ambulance is summoned to the person's residence.

The 24-hour response system will serve the communities of Terrace Bay, Schreiber, Jackfish, Rossport and Pays Plat.

Community organizations have raised approximately \$16,000 of the \$45,000 system which was put into operation earlier in November.
