## NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF A ZONING BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Terrace Bay passed By-law No. 39-89 on the 11th day of December, 1989, under section 34 of the Planning Act, 1983.


AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or agency may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the by-law by filing with the Clerk of the Corporation of the Township of Terrace Bay not later than the 9th day of January, 1990, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the by-law and the reasons in support of the objection.

An explanation of the purpose and effect of the by-law, describing the lands to which the by-law applies is attached below. The complete by-law is available for inspection in my office during regular office hours.

Explanatory Note Re: By-Law No. 39-89



By-Law No. 39-89 changes the zone category of approximately 5.55 hectares of land adjacent to the Terrace Bay-Schreiber Landfill Site from "MX" (Extractive Industrial) to "MD" (Disposal Industrial) to permit the construction of drying beds for treated sewage sludge.
