### Extension of Time for Return of Annual Assessment Rolls

Pursuant to section 35 of the Assessment Act, I hereby further extend to the 27th day of February, 1990, the day upon which the assessment rolls for the year 1989 are required to be returned pursuant to the provisions of the said Act in all municipalities and localities in the Province of Ontario except the City of Welland and the municipalities located in the Regional Municipality of Sudbury, the County of Kent, the County of Prince Edward and the County of Renfrew.

And notice is hereby given that the final date for lodging a complaint with the Assessment Review Board in respect of any assessment contained in the assessment rolls that are required to be returned on the 27th day of February, 1990 is further extended to the 20th day of March, 1990.
