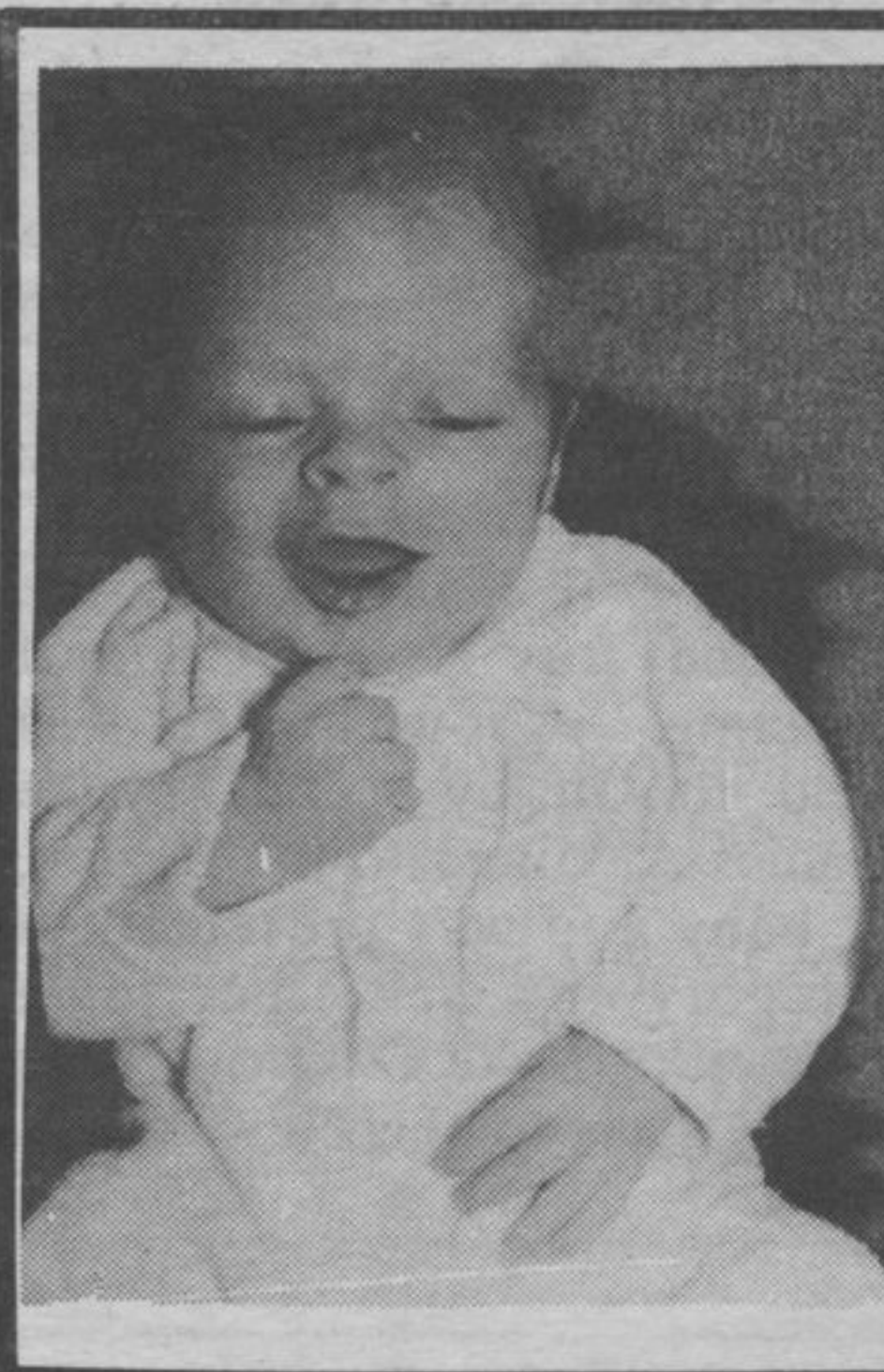

Contiki Holidays Travel Throughout Europe

In 1980 I booked on to a Contiki trip. It was an 8 1/2 week bus tour of Western and Eastern Europe. I didn't know what to expect, because two years before I had had the freedom of backpacking around Europe for 4 months with no strings attached and pretty much staying wherever and for how long I wanted.

In fact, I was so impressed and had so much fun that over the years I've recommended friends and as of last year, started booking trips with Contiki myself.

If you're between the ages of 18-35, on a budget, can't wait to experience Europe and thrive on non-stop action a Contiki Concept Tour is for you.

Contiki Tours start from 14 days and 6 countries and run up to 52 days and 14 countries. What makes Contiki so special is the age group and the cost. The price you pay includes meals, accommodations, top quality coach travel, side trips and sightseeing tours, plus the professional services you receive from your tour manager, bus driver, and stop-over and village staff.

On a Contiki Tour whether you go alone or with a friend you will travel with up to 50 other people from all over the world, all walks of life and all kinds of interests that have the same thing in common with you... to see and enjoy Europe.

You will travel throughout Europe on Contiki's own fleet of Mercedes Benz coaches. Each coach is fitted with reclining seats, panoramic tinted windows, personal writing tables, air-jet ventilation and built-in stereo sound system. They are driven by carefully trained drivers who have passed the toughest driving tests in all of Europe and believe me to drive in some of the countries in Europe, whether on the motorways or narrow back streets you have to be good.

As for accommodations, they are unreal... you will stay in a wide range of carefully chosen historic and exciting places from Chateau's in France, to villas and palazzo's in Italy that are exclusive to Contiki. Typical amenities at Contiki special stopovers include a bar, dance hall, swimming pools, tennis courts or are close to the beach.

Of course when travelling away from home, food is one of the major concerns and Contiki has put much thought into the planning of meals. Breakfast and dinner are included daily except on some occasions when you and your friends on tour will enjoy a national meal in the country you are in. Lunch is pretty well left up to yourself.

The most important person on your tour would have to be your

tour manager. He or she will show you the best of Europe, take care of all the hassles, fill you in on the local information and history and get you to where the action is day or night.

So what's it all cost?... well prices vary from \$699.00 for 2 weeks to \$2320.00 for 7 weeks, plus air fare from Canada to London, England which is your tour departure and return point.

Contiki also offers hotel tours and camping tours and operates besides Europe in Australia, New Zealand, Russia, and the United States and Hawaii.

I've told you as much as I can in an article, but there is lots more such as which countries to visit, what sites to see, and what is included in each day's itinerary. Tours start running from the end of March to the end of October. For Contiki brochures and a viewing of the Contiki video of Europe, just give me a call or talk to me anytime. I can't promise you a great time because that depends on yourself, but I can put you on the right track. But, hey don't just take my word about the perfect, no worry, no hassle, good time holiday, just ask John or Raymond Bouchard, Mark Malashenski, Scott Randa or Alain Zborowski (you would have to drop Al a line in Cockatoo, Australia.) They have all taken Contiki holidays and had a great time. It's an experience you won't want to miss!!
