Criminal Court Report

Criminal Court was held on 07 March 1990 at Legion Hall in Schreiber. Judge Walneck presided over a lengthy Court Docket (schedule).

James Leonard Callaghan of Terrace Bay pled guilty to Impaired Driving and Escape Lawful Custody. He was sentenced to 14 days in jail and his license was suspended for two years. He was given a two day jail sentence on the Escape Custody charge.

David Paul Dittburner of Whitesand Lake pled guilty to Impaired Driving and Fail to Provide a Breath Sample.

Dittburner also pled guilty to wounding. The incident that resulted in this charge was the October 18th evening when Dittburner shot Onesime Cloutier with a 12 gauge shotgun. Dittburner will be sentenced to all charges in Thunder Bay on 20 April 1990.

Gary James Dunnett of Terrace Bay pled guilty to Drive While Suspended and Personation. He was given a

\$253.75 and a \$100.00 fine consecutively.

Joseph Figliomeni Jr., of 205 Newman Street, Schreiber, pled guilty to Assault. He was given a \$500.00 fine and placed on probation for two years. This charge was a result of a quarrel on 28 July 1989 in which Figliomeni kicked and choked a young girl. The two year probation includes not coming in contact with the girl.

A Bench Warrant was issued for Michael Harvey. This stems from a Terrace Bay Police charge of Possession of Stolen Property.

Dean Johnson of Terrace Bay pled guilty to a Terrace Bay P.F. charge of Assault. He was given a \$200.00 fine.

Gavin MacKay of Schreiber pled guilty to three Impaired Driving charges and two possession of a Narcotics charge. He will be sentenced on 02 May 1990.

Peter Gutta of Schreiber was to be sentenced on his Break and Enter charge but it was put over until 02 May 1990.

Timothy Richardson of Schreiber pled guilty to Impaired Driving. He was given an \$800.00 fine and a one year license suspension.
