

Criminal Court Report

Criminal Court was held on o7 March 1990 at Legion Hall in Schreiber. Judge Walneck predided over a lengthy Court Docket (schedule).

James Leonard Callaghan of Terrace Bay pled guilty to Impaired Driving and Escape Lawful Custody. He was sentenced to 14 days in jail and his license was suspended for two years. He was given a two day jail sentence on the Escape Custody charge.

David Paul Dittburner of Whitesand Lake pled guilty to Impaired Driving and Fail to Provide a Breath Sample.

Dittburner also pled guilty to wounding. The incident that resulted in this charge was the October 18th evening when Dittburner shot Onesime Cloutier with a 12 gauge shotgun. Dittburner will be sentenced to all charges in Thunder Bay on 20 April 1990.

Gary James Dunnett of Terrace Bay pled guilty to Drive While Suspended and Personation. He was given a


