

TVOntario's Poster Contest

TVOntario has announced a poster contest for Ontario school children from kindergarten to grade 13 to celebrate its twentieth anniversary 27 September 1990. There will be three winners in

the five following categories--preschool and kindergarten, grades 1 to 3, grades 4 to 6, grades 7 to 9, and grades 10 to OAC. Out of 15 winning pictures, TVOntario will choose a

grand-prize winner, an illustration that will be used as the main visual on TVOntario's twentieth-anniversary posters to be distributed to the public.

An identical contest will be conducted for francophone students, with the winning illustration appearing on a French-language twentieth-anniversary poster.

All 15 winning posters in each language will be shown on TVOntario's English- and French-language services, TVO and la chaine Francaise, and the artists will receive a TVOntario sweat shirt. The school of each category winner will also receive video-

tapes of TVOntario series, selected by the school, to a maximum of 120 minutes of programming.

Posters must be two-dimensional only and in full color (paints, crayons, watercolors, colored pencils, colored paper, Magic Markers, or similar materials may be used). Posters must be drawn on bright white paper or Bristol board, and must be submitted without creases. The illustrated area of the poster must be square and have a minimum size of 14" x 14".

All entries must be delivered

to TVOntario by the closing date of the contest, 18 May 1990, at the latest. Winning posters will be selected on 8 June 1990 by TVOntario on the basis of skill, originality, artistic rendering, and relevance to TVOntario and its twentieth-anniversary celebrations. The winners, as selected by TVOntario, will be telephoned by the second week of June 1990.

Each contestant is allowed one entry, and submission of more than one entry will result in disqualification. Entry forms are available at local schools.
