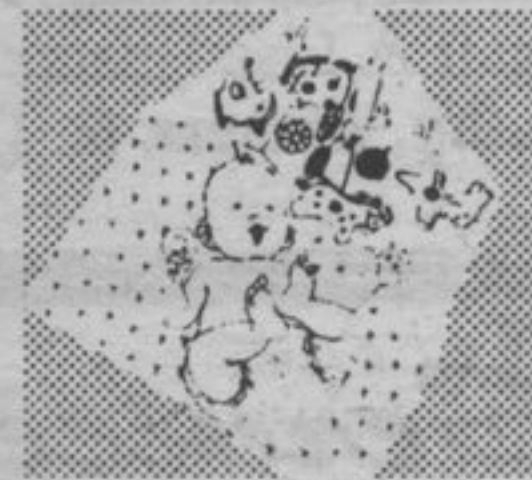

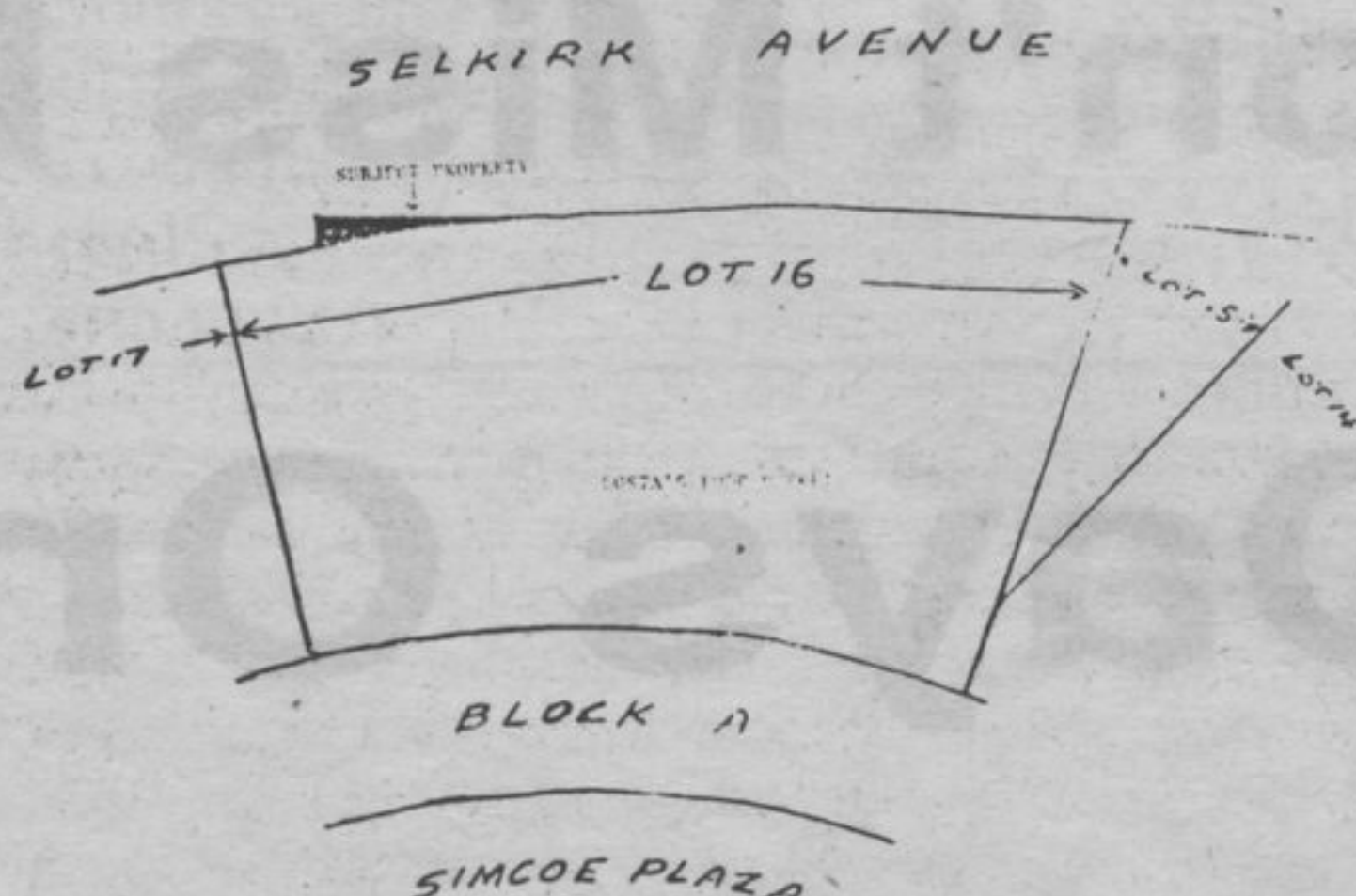
PUBLIC NOTICE
