Criminal Court Report

On 04 April 1990, Judge Ray Walneck presided over Criminal Court in Schreiber.

He pled guilty to "False Pretence" and given a Conditional Discharge and ordered to make \$500.00 restitution to Imperial Restaurant and ordered to give another \$100.00 donation to Minor Baseball.
