A birthday party was held for Mr. Jack Handel at his home. It was attended by many relations and friends.

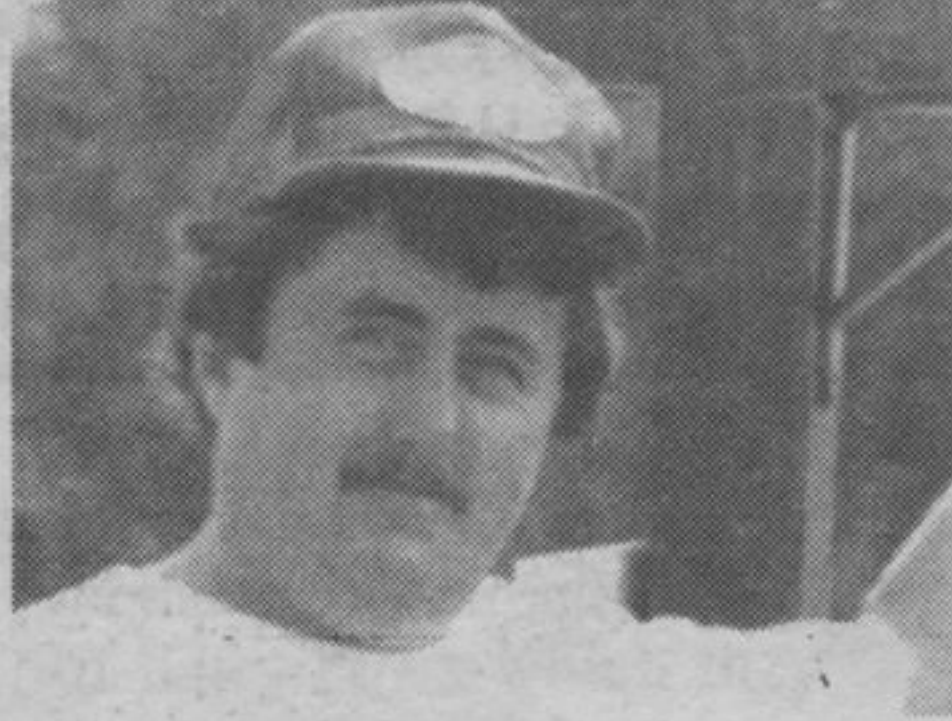
Ethel Devon from Eganville is here visiting her sister Rita and Mike McGrath.

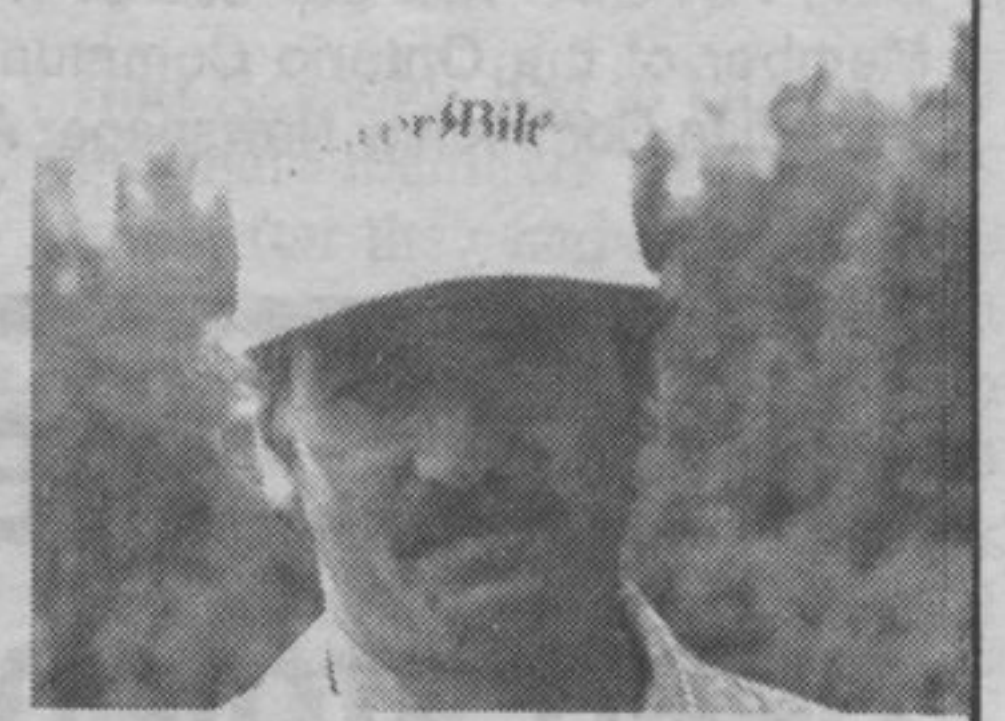
