You're on the wrong track

This year, National School Safety Week, October 15-19, 1990 is promoting railway safety. The Canada Safety Council is supporting Operation Lifesaver's 10th Anniversary anti-trespassing program "You are on the Wrong Track". This program informs people of the dangers of trespassing on railway property or playing on railway equipment.

As adults, we must ensure that young people are aware of rail/highway crossing hazards. Children, as they are particularly vulnerable, must be taught that railway tracks and railway property are very dangerous and are not places to play. Safe behaviours practised now will carry over into teen and adult years.

This railway safety booklet is designed to provide teachers, parents and children with the opportunity to discuss railway safety. The activity sheets in the booklet can be reproduced and used either at school or at home. A guide to using the activity sheets is provided on page 14 of the booklet. We have included this booklet in our media mailings in order that media representatives can familiarize themselves with the focus of this year's initiative.

National School Safety Week, sponsored by the Canada Safety Council and Provincial Safety Councils and Leagues, provides an opportunity to highlight the vital importance of safety education and stimulates students involvement in accident prevention activities not only during the campaign week, but throughout the year.
