The second session runs from Monday, Nov. 5. to Sunday, Nov. 16. This will be the last class before the new year.

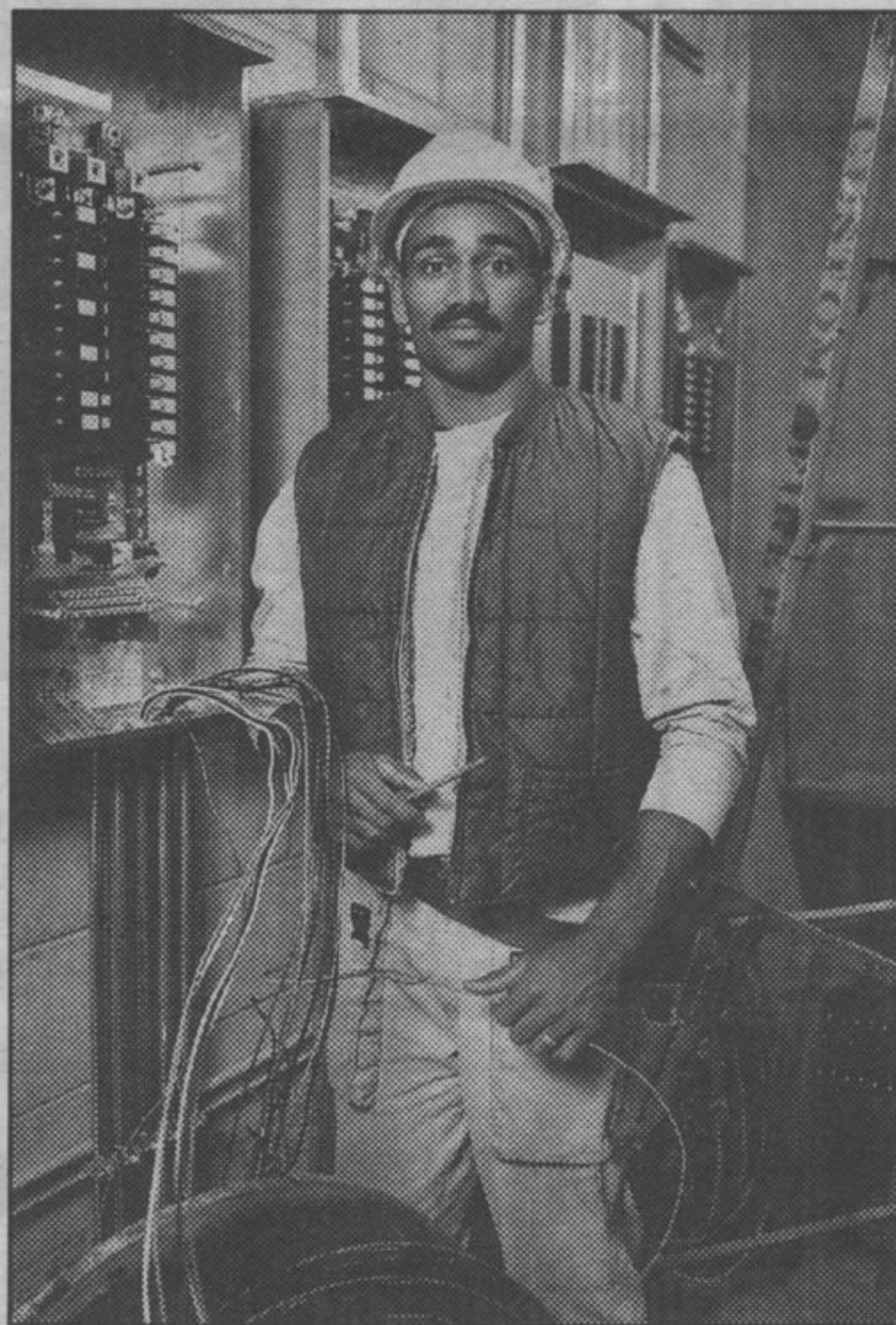
