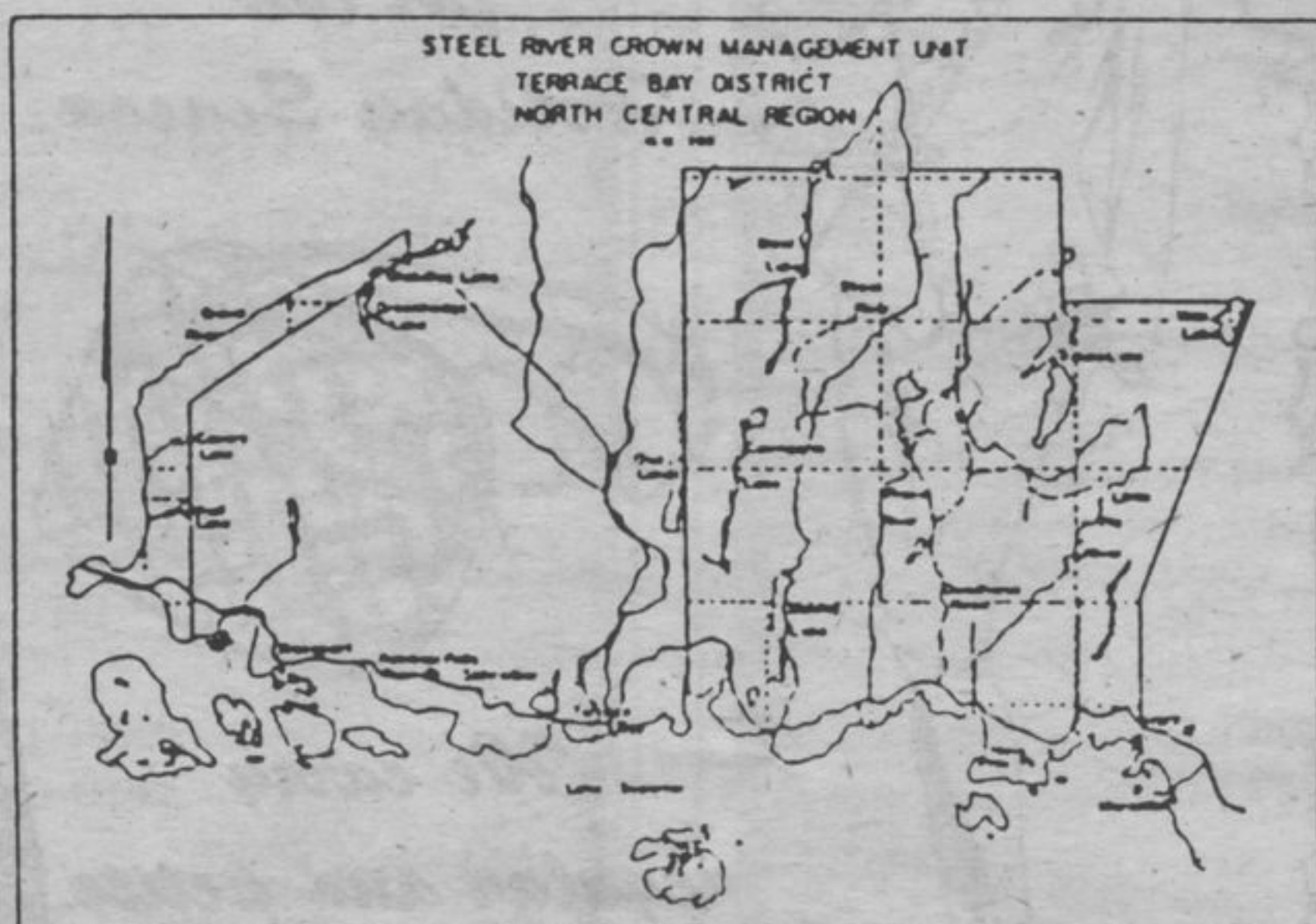
PUBLIC NOTICE

PUBLIC REVIEW OF THE DRAFT TIMBER MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE STEEL RIVER CROWN MANAGEMENT UNIT (1991-1996)

The Ministry of Natural Resources would like to invite interested participants to review the draft Timber Management Plan for the Steel River Crown Management Unit, supplementary documentation, and MNR's preliminary list of outstanding required alterations, if any. This public review will take place prior to approval of the draft plan or, if required, production of a revised plan. Opportunity will be available:

- * to review how their earlier comments and submissions have been considered in the preparation of the draft Timber Management Plan;
- * to comment on decisions which have been made;
- * to review, and comment on, MNR's preliminary list of outstanding required alterations; and
- * to review the field of environmental planning procedure for forest access roads (The Jack Pine Extension and the Esker Lake Road including the Steel River Waterway Park Crossing) under the Class EA exemption order MNR 11/9.

A thirty (30) day review period is provided for interested participants to review the draft Timber Management Plan, to present comments and submissions regarding MNR's preliminary list of outstanding required alterations, and to suggest additional alterations. The thirty (30) day period ends December 14, 1990.

Ringette is a dynamic team sport of speed stamina, timing, balance and precision on ice skates.

This week players and supporters of Ringette will celebrate Gillette Soft and Dri National Ringette Week.

The local Ringette organization will be holding an exhibition game and demonstration of Ringette skills at the Terrace Bay Arena Thursday, Nov. 15 at 7 p.m.

This unique Canadian game, invented in 1963 by Sam Jacks of North Bay is played by 30,000 girls and women across the country.

Players range in age from 4 to 64 and are divided into nine nationally recognized age groups, with competition and participation at different skill levels.

Ringette has grown across Canada and to other countries such as the U.S.A., Finland, France, Sweden, New Zealand and the U.S.S.R.

The first ever World Ringette Championships were held in Gloucester, Ontario this past year.
