## New provincial organ donor organization

Drivers who have signed the organ donor portion of their drivers' licences should now contact the Multiple Organ Retrieval and Exchange Program of Ontario if they want more information about participating in organ and tissue donation programs.

This a change from the information now provided on Ontario licences which tells drivers to direct questions to the chief coroner's office.

MORE has assumed the responsibility from the chief coroner for answering public inquiries about the Human Tissues Gift Act.

Cheryl Rosell, MORE executive director, said persons should keep their signed donor cards in their wallets or purses with other personal identification.

"The card should not be sent to MORE," she said.

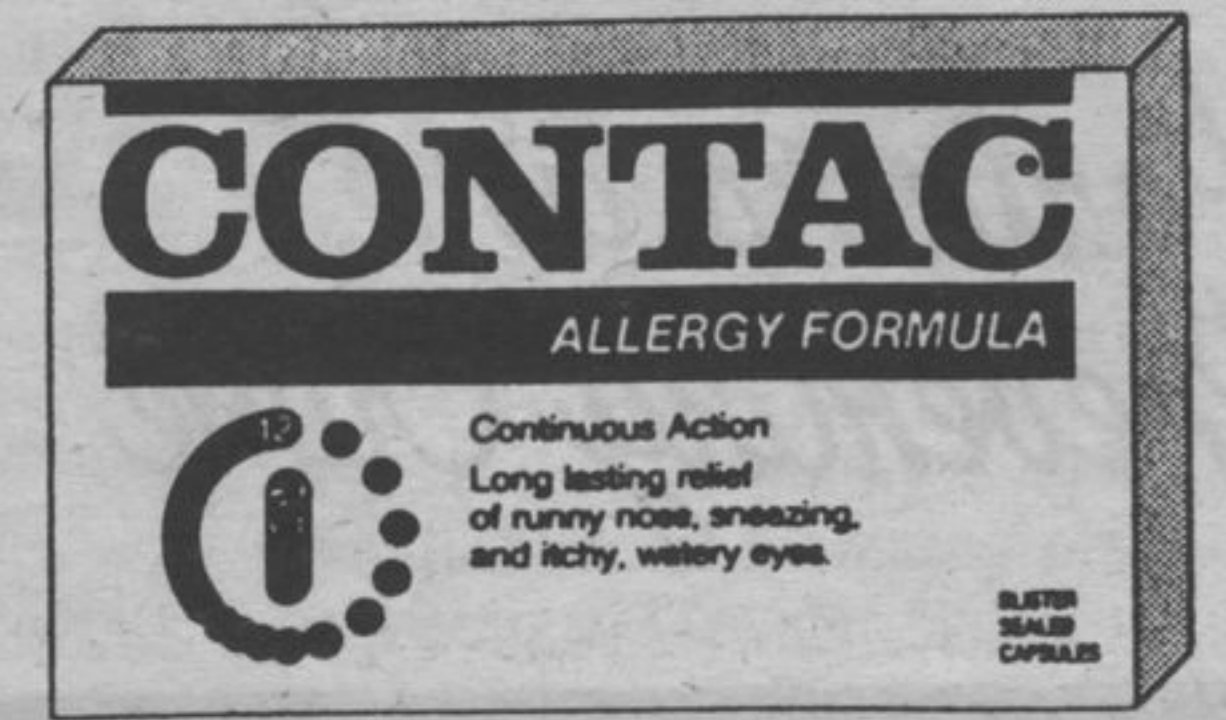
Rosell also urged those who sign cards to discuss their wishes openly with their families.

"While the signed cards are very valuable in indicating a patient's wish to be considered as an organ donor," she explained, "hospitals will not retrieve over the objections of next of kin."

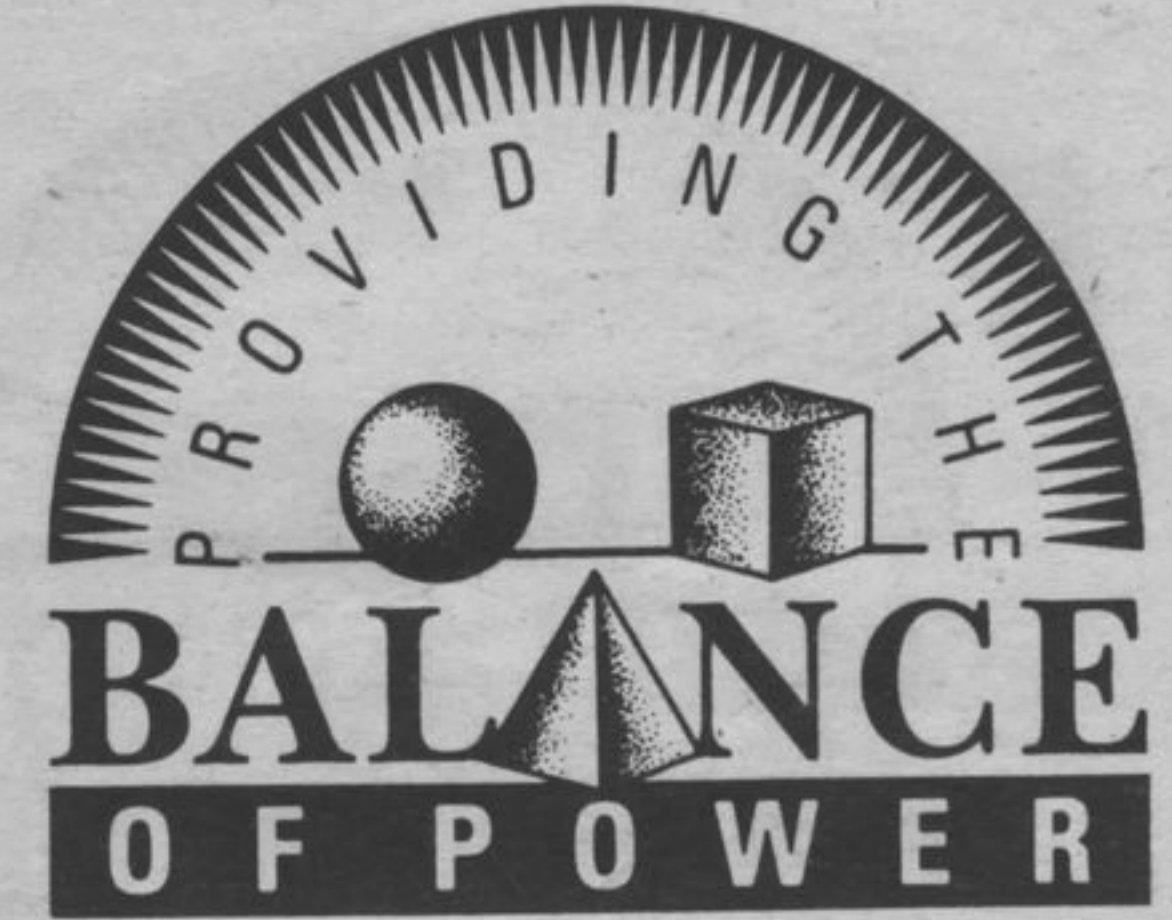
MORE is a non-profit organization funded by the Ministry of Health to provide professional public education programs and materials on organ and tissue donation and transplantation.

It also manages the provincial computer system which allocates organs that have been donated.

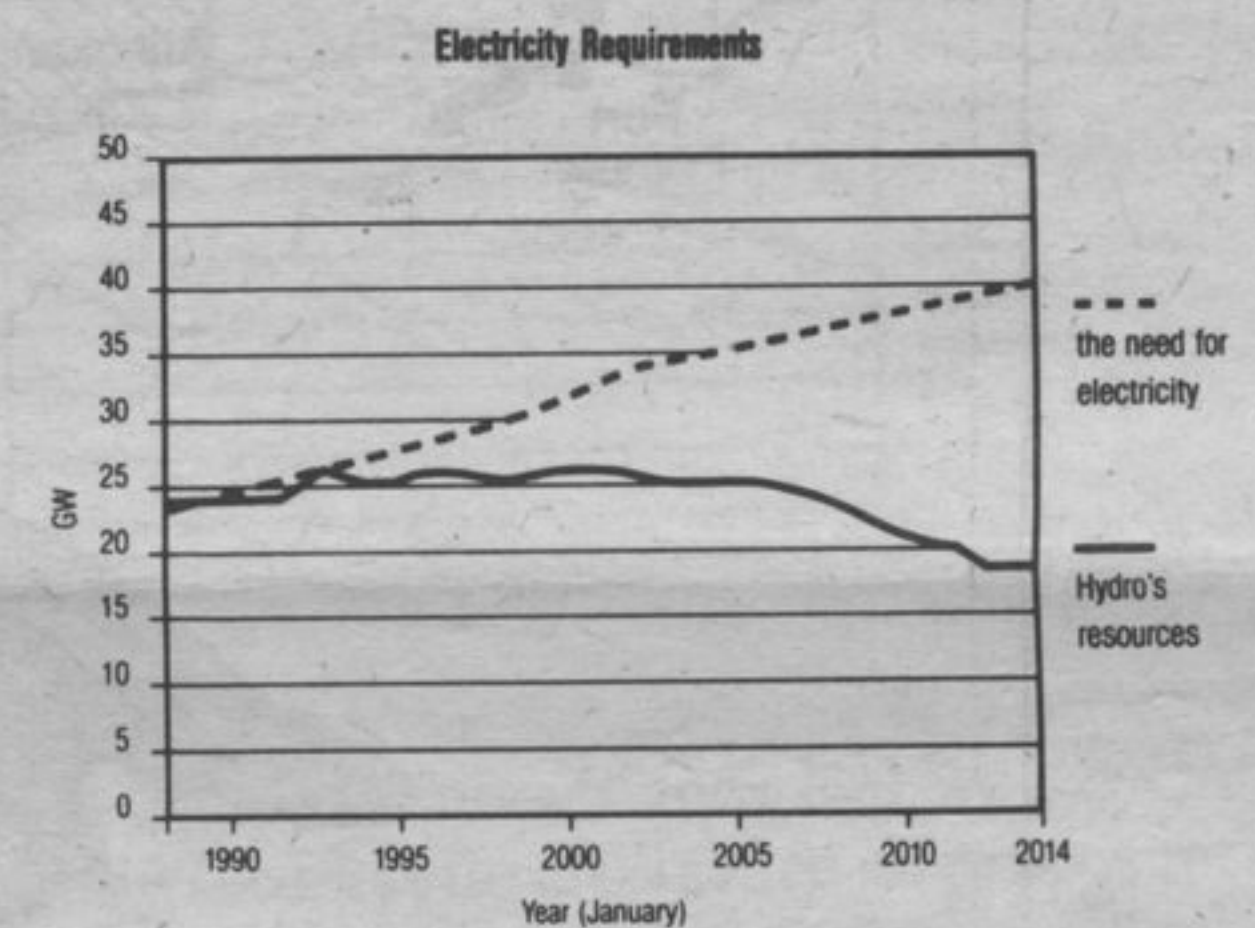

## Ontario Hydro is beginning a route selection study for a new transmission line to Manitoba

The province's demand for electricity has been growing steadily -- and -- forecasts indicate that Ontario will need 50% to 100% more electricity over the next 25 years.



Ontario Hydro's "Balance of Power" proposal sets out to meet this energy challenge in a number of ways, one of which calls for the purchase of 1000 megawatts of electricity annually from Manitoba Hydro beginning in the year 2000. This would require construction of a new high voltage transmission line from the Manitoba border to either the Timmins or the Sault Ste. Marie area.

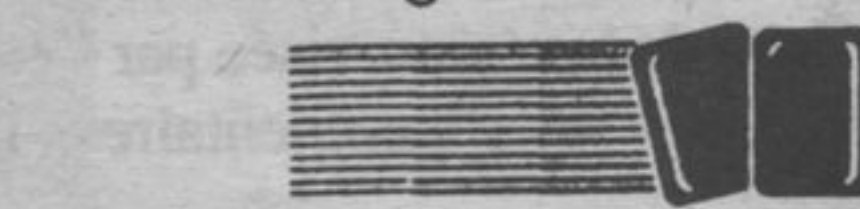
