Homemade treats for your pets

Christmas is the time of year we all tend to indulge ourselves. Your pets would love to have all the treats that you are having, but his health could be affected by them.

Many dogs have a fatal reaction after consuming chocolate so have those sweets for yourself.

If you would like to make a special treat for your dog or cat, then try these easy recipes.

Jerky for Pets and People

One pound of lean beef
Remove excess fat

Slice meat diagonally across the grain into strips 1/8 - 1/4 inch thick

Marinate the strips for two hours in:

- 1/4 cup salad oil
- 1/2 cup soy sauce
- 1 large clove of garlic crushed

1 tablespoon sugar

Remove meat from marinade and sprinkle lightly with salt and pepper

Place meat strips in the oven on a wire rack over a drip pan or hang strips over the rack bars with a drip pan placed below.

Heat oven to 175 F

Leave oven door slightly ajar and dry strips for approximately five hours

Remove jerky when dry but still slightly flexible.

Cool and store in an airtight container.

Dog Biscuits

1 cup all purpose flour

1 cup wheat flour

1/2 cup wheat germ

1/2 cup powdered milk

1/2 tsp salt

6 tbs margarine, lard chilled

1 egg

1 tsp brown sugar

Combine flour's wheat germ, powdered milk and salt in a bowl. Cut in shortening until mixture resembles corn meal.

Beat sugar with the egg, then stir in the flour mixture.

Add water gradually as necessary to make a stiff dough (approximately 1/2 cup).

Knead on a floured board until dough is smooth and pliable.

Then roll out 1/2 inch thickness and cut with a cookie cutter.

Bake at 325 F until lightly brown. Makes two dozen biscuits
