" I should have kept track of all the bootees I've knit over the years," she said.


She also mans the Auxiliary's Gift Shop at the Hospital once a week.

Where you really are just a number, instead of a person, like you are on a smaller campus? Distressingly, the report adds that the negative message about northern post-secondary education just doesn't come from the young people themselves. It's also perpetrated by their high school guidance counsellors. That's something that can be changed, one would hope.

But on the larger problem of northern Ontario's "loser image", it will take more than just seminars for high school guidance counsellors to turn that one around. I am optimistic. In the nearly two decades that I've lived in northern Saskatchewan, the Northwest Territories, or northern Ontario, I've sensed a growing pride among northerners that we not only like who we are and where we live, but that those grinding out their lives on expressways in the south have nothing on us. We have fewer problems with crime, housing, and smog - not to mention traffic. We adults seem have to sold ourselves on the advantages of being a northerner. Now all we have to do is convince our kids.
