

Quick and easy access to winter road reports

Ontario's Ministry of Transportation has recently improved its Winter Road Reporting Service for the public.

With the addition of a voice-activated automatic telephone

system, the public now has quick and easy access to more detailed driving condition information.

The Road Information Centre in Toronto and ministry offices throughout Ontario

continue to offer up-to-date, 24-hours-a-day information on the current conditions of all provincial and secondary highways, seven days a week from November to April.

The Ministry of Transportation has also expanded its French Road Information Service to include the areas of Cochrane, Midland and St. Catharines as well as toll free line for callers in the 613 area code.

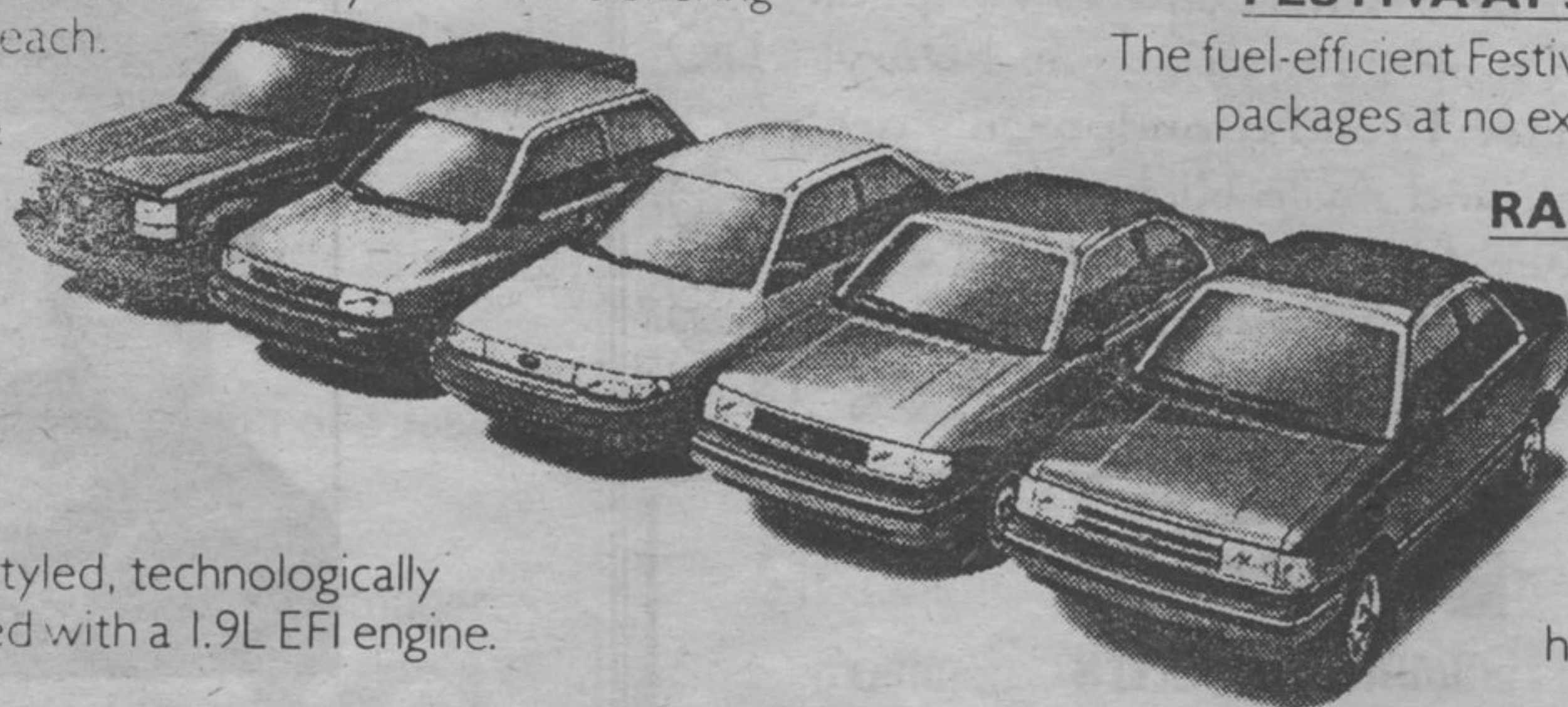
