Buddy, with his high energy and twisted logic led the audience through a night of music and laughter that left them feeling happy and relaxed.

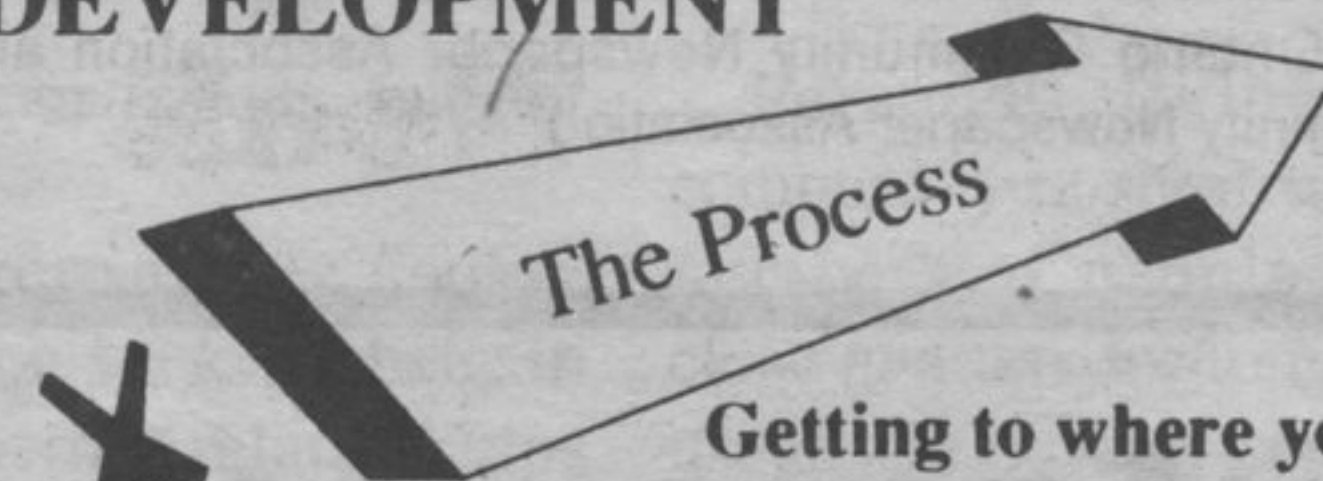
