One of the groups that can sometimes be overlooked for pets is the terriers, Group 4. Some of the terriers can be feisty with other dogs such as the Fox Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier, Schauzer, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, West Highland White Terrier and Scottish Terrier (better known as the Scotty).

But these dogs are extremely loyal to their owners and family. The Airdale, Australian, Bedlington, Border, Bull Terrier, Cairn, Dandie Dinmont, Irish, Kerry Blue, Lakeland, Manchester, Norfolk, Norwich, Sealyham, Soft-coated Wheaten and Welsh Terrier are some types of dogs in this group.

All of these dogs were bred for hunting vermin underground or in water. Many need very little grooming and do not shed. Some are good to own if you have allergies such as the Kerry Blue Terrier, Airdale and Soft-coated Wheaten.

Because some terriers are hard to find you may have to wait a year before getting a puppy but it will be worth the wait. Australian, Norfolk and Norwich have very few breeders in Canada and you may have to look in the United States.

When visiting a kennel call before and make an appointment to see your future puppy's parents. Don't expect to take your pup home right away. It is far more important to find the right breeder and patiently await a pup than to have an instant pet.

## Crafts for Kids

### Easter Eggs

Blocking Techniques

Dip small flowers, grasses, fresh herbs, etc into salad oil, egg white or vegetable glue. Arrange these on the surface of an undyed, hardboiled egg. Wrap a single layer of nylon stocking or gauze tightly around the egg and tie at both ends with thread.

This keeps the flower, grasses, etc. pressed against the egg. Put the egg into the dye until desired shade is achieved. Dry.

Remove gauze and flower. The imprint of the flower or grasses will now be on the egg.

In place of flowers, grasses etc. you may use small cloth or paper cutouts. If these are non-colorfast, the imprint will be in colour. You may rub a drop of salad oil to add luster.

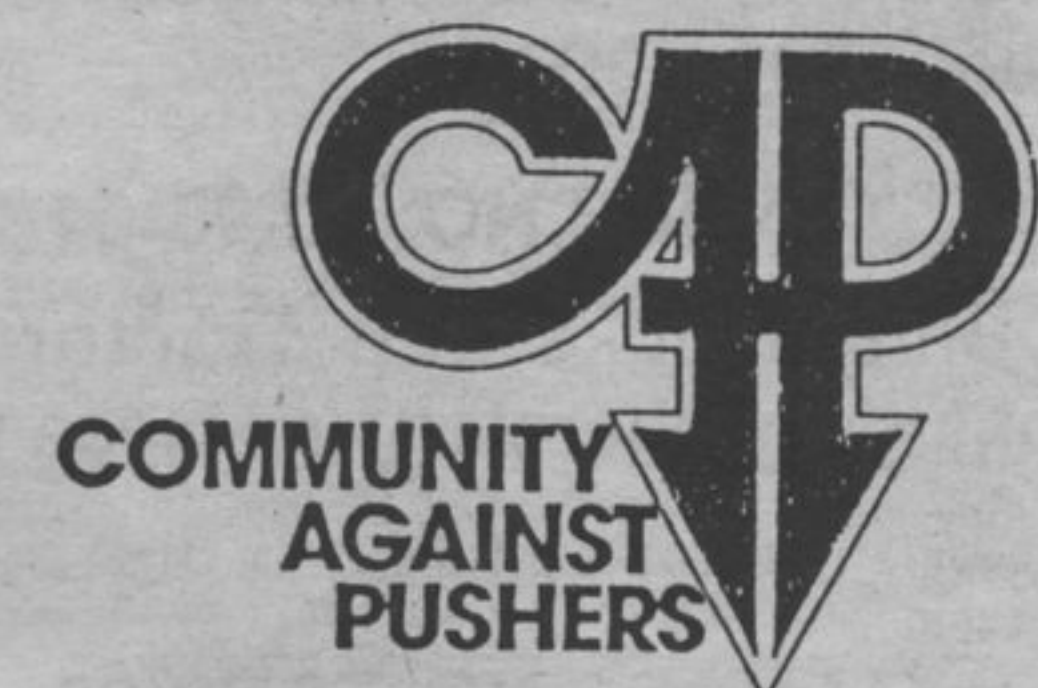
