The last ten years of his job with the Metro force he was assigned to the Combined Forces Special Enforcement Unit, a joint squad including the RCMP and the OPP, that worked exclusively on organized crime.

"I was very lucky to have had the opportunity to able to do just about everything," Kidder said.

Kidder worked undercover for a total of seven years of plainclothes experience.

"I even sat and posed as a hitman in a case where there was a contract out on a guy. We charged a man with conspiracy to kill his father."

In 1972 Kidder achieved one of his goals when he became a Detective.

"I remember it well," he said, "I made the rank of Detective and a week later they changed the rank Investigative Sergeant."

The only thing that I can ever say I didn't like about police work was when they changed that rank. It affected me directly. I had always wanted to be a detective - that is what I strived for. I was a detective for one week."

The long hours of continual

work made him decide to move north in 1986.

"I have no regrets about coming to Terrace Bay," he

"The citizens have come together, when required, to assist the police, and the officers have done their jobs well and thoroughly."

He also pointed out the idea of community policing is in full effect in Terrace Bay.

"I have found the Council to be very community minded. They have born the brunt of the cost of community policing and they haven't hesitated in doing so."

Kidder made it a point to mention the kids in town.

"They're much better behaved and much more polite than kids in other communities I've worked in."
