Flatliners starring Keifer Sutherland, Julia Roberts
Rating: 0 poor.....10 excellent

A dark, gritty movie that delves into the uncharted territory of life-after-death and challenges 4 young medical students as they never have been before.

Keifer Sutherland is Nelson; a volatile egomaniac who has decided to see if there really is anything on the other side. He coaxes, threatens and brow-beats the others into helping him. Julia Roberts is Rachel; quiet and mysteriously seductive. Kevin Bacon is Labraccio; a level-headed atheist who (once he becomes your friend) is blindly loyal. William Baldwin is Joe; a video-taping womanizer who cares only for the good times. Oliver Pratt is Steckle; the classic glasses and bowtie

nerd who's devotion to science is matched only by his devotion to the rules.

Together these 4 take a trip to the other side. They each (except one) allow their hearts to be stopped with an electrical shock. After a pre-set time, the others revive the flat-liner. As each one comes back, he or she brings something else back. something not pleasant and in one case, something deadly. Now they must figure out how to escape their nightmares or lose their sanity.

Is there life-after-death and if so - is it good? This movie may not give you the answers to that, but it certainly is an interesting perspective on the subject. I give Flatliners a 9.
