The Grade 8 class of Terrace Bay Public School has collected books, magazines comic books and other material to send the Adege Primary School in Bendel State, West Africa.

The students have also written letters to the Nigerian students as well as short essays about life on the Northshore including transportation, sports, the school system, recreation and leisure, music, holidays, weather, clothing.

The class had been reading and studying novels with themes of interculture encounters when it discovered that students from Nigeria had been writing to The Township of Terrace Bay. Judy Wilcox, Administrative Assistance with the Township had been receiving the letters.

Wilcox, on her own initiative, answered one letter from a Adege Primary School

The Township of Terrace Bay, for its part, agreed to pay the cost of posting the package to Nigeria.
