In other words, it's a laissezfaire policy, not unlike the one followed by the late Chairman Mao Tse-tung during China's Cultural Revolution, where he called for "a thousand flowers to bloom" in local government structures.

So that's where Ottawa is coming from, as Canada defines this new relationship with aboriginal people. In the next installment, the last in this series, we'll describe the government negotiations take place.


