years, if I'm going to be realistic." The federal legislation he's talking about would move NAN from under the jurisdiction of the Indian Act to the jurisdiction of this new "NAN government" legislation.

The conclusion I reach from all this is that a very new wheel is being invented here - through consensus-building, rather than confrontation. This wheel is "new" because, although other native self-gov-

ernment models are being studied (such as the Navaho government in the United States), no other system exists that really takes into account the unique set of circumstances in NAN-46 widely dispersed communities with few internal resources for self-development. Power sharing among the local band councils, tribal councils and NAN itself, not to mention the federal and provincial governments, will be complex.

Rosehart said the negotiations, at least at this early stage, are moving slowly but smoothly. He did nothing to down-play the complexities, or provide clear definitions. But if his overall optimism is justified, we really will be able to say some day that northern Ontario has yet another model to offer the rest of Canada - a model of native self-government.

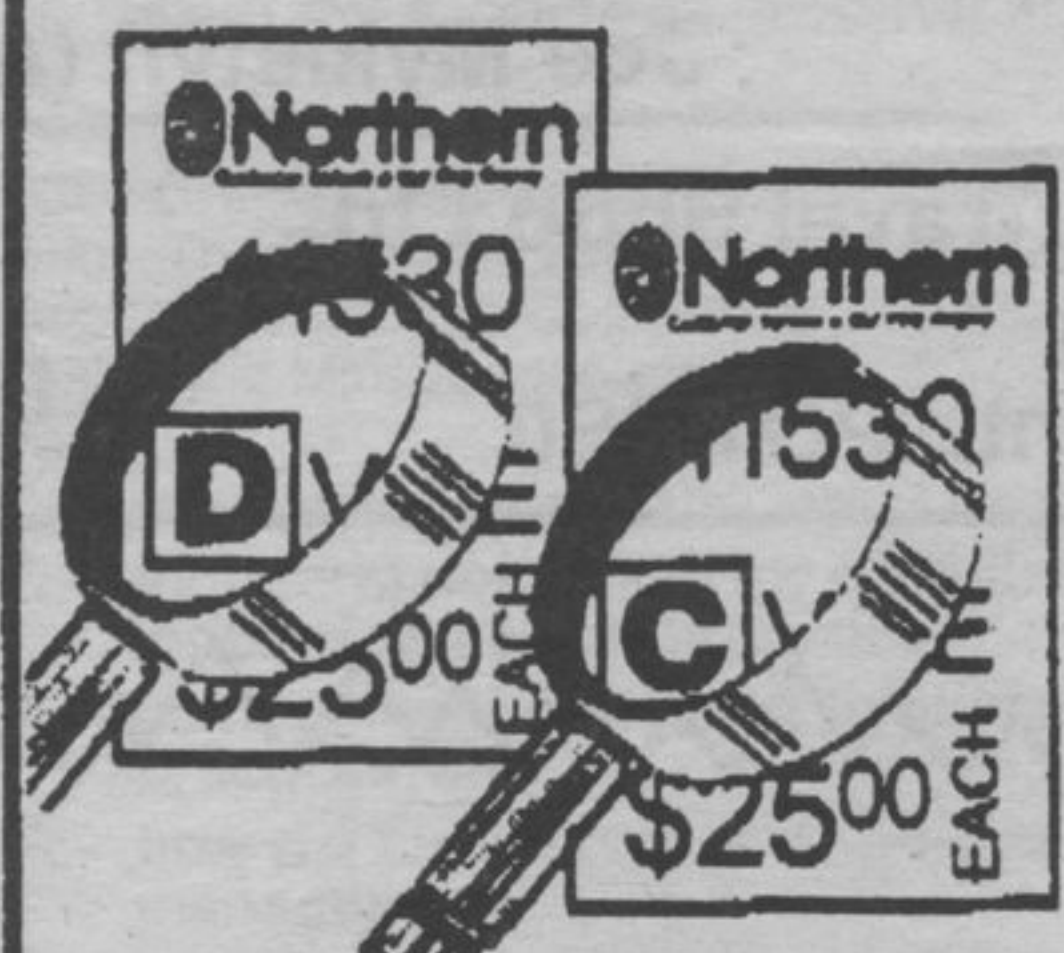

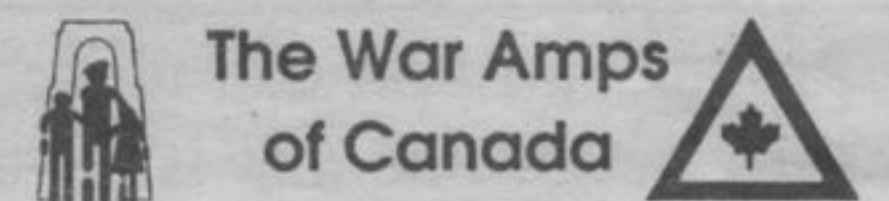
