The brother is forced to choose between supporting his sister's efforts or upholding the chauvinist attitudes of his teammates.

This is a play with a strong message - that you must be true to yourself above all else. The message does not advocate feminist rights, but the rights of an individual to be able to do whatever he or she chooses.

The production was presented by the Sault Youth Theatre.

"All the plays we do are Canadian," said Steve Ballantine, director/producer for the group. He added that "it takes some real looking" to find good plays with a direct message.


Not all of their pieces are intended for a young audience.

They do not emphasize male or female perspectives, but put people first. The plays are presented from a humanist point of view.
