we'll never find



Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources REQUEST FOR COMMUNITY PROPOSALS COMMUNITY FOREST PILOT PROJECTS

The Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources is seeking proposals from communities, municipalities, community groups and other organizations who are interested in becoming directly involved in the management of the local forest resource base to identify areas for four community forest pilot projects.

The proposals shall be in the form of a statement of community interest indicating:

- the proponent's objective or purpose for increasing its involvement in forest management
- a description of the community or partners who wish to become more involved in forest management

the geographic area of the proposed community forest

- those aspects of forest management in which the community wishes to become involved and the nature of its proposed involvement
- the financial commitment which the community is prepared to undertake to implement the project

The Ministry of Natural Resources wishes to facilitate the development of community forest pilot projects throughout the Crown forest land base of Ontario.

Financial and technical advisory assistance will be made available to those project proponents who are selected.

The pilot projects will assist the ministry with developing long-term policy aimed at empowering community partners with responsibility for various aspects of Crown forest resource management.
