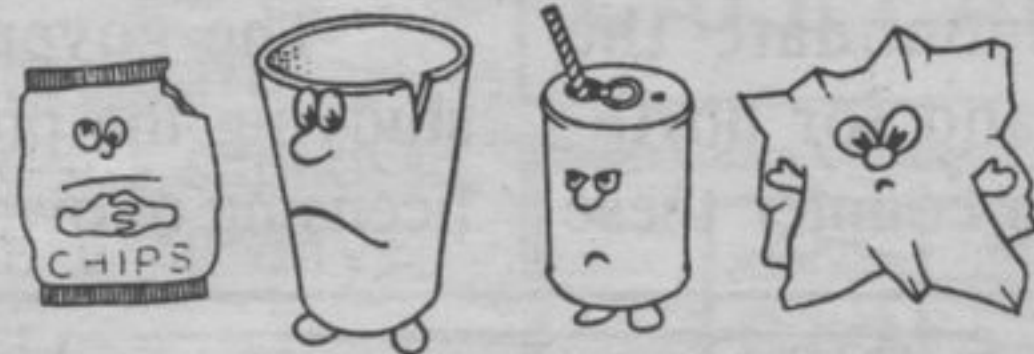


Colouring contest for kids at CIBC

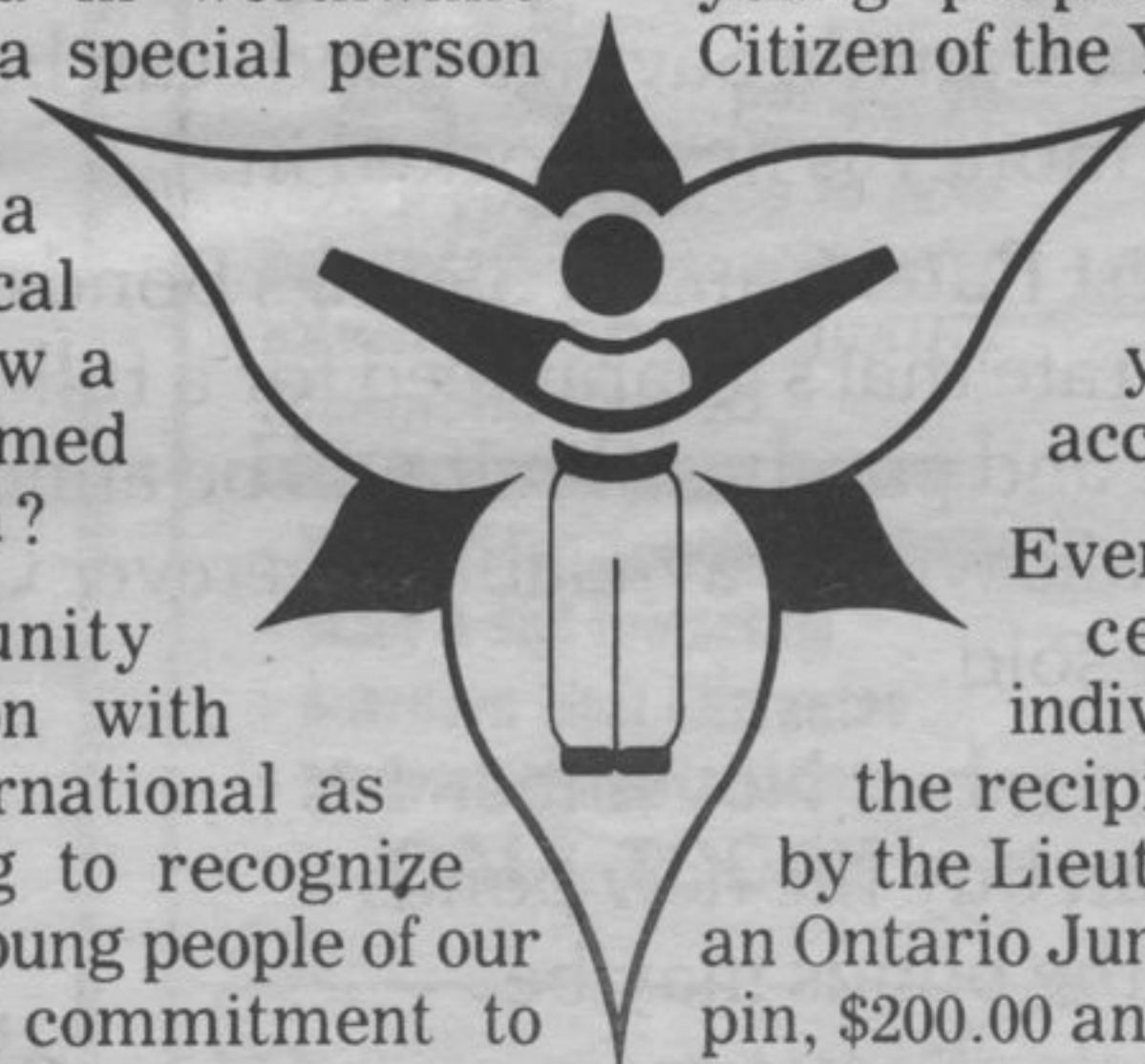

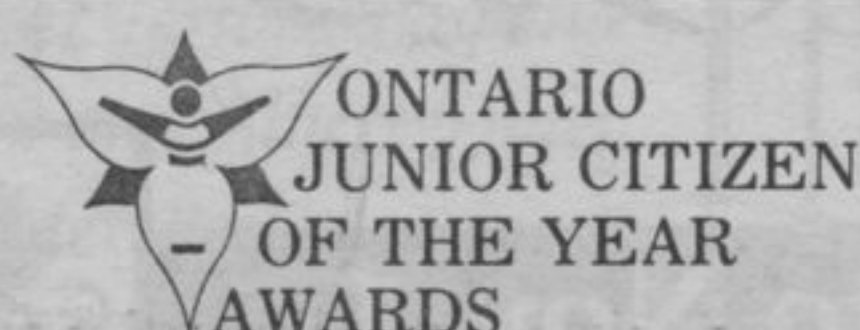
