Spring and fall have always been seasons for families to bring a puppy into their home.

I have received many calls from people asking how to house break their puppy correctly.

Puppy is a baby

First, you must remember that a seven week old puppy is a baby. They do not have the ability to control themselves yet. In fact, usually it is not until the puppy is three to four months old that they start to have good bladder con-

trol.

The easiest way to prevent mistakes is to form good behaviour at the beginning of his arrival.

One of the easiest methods is to have a training crate. This is not a jail for your puppy, and should not be used as a substitute for human companionship. It still will need plenty of attention and exercise.

Crate not a prison

The crate is a special place for the pup, and it is his own private den. By using the crate you are preventing bad

habits before they start.

A dog doesn't like to soil his sleeping area, so he learns to control himself while he's in his crate.

You can't leave the puppy in there for 12 hours, but within a few weeks, you should be able to put him in there at 11 p.m. and take him out again at seven the next morning.

Use kitchen or porch

If you are unable to purchase a crate, use a kitchen or a porch area and confine your puppy in these areas with newspapers on the floor.

Try to bring the puppy into the rest of the household while you are home for a week or two. This way you can teach him from the beginning what he should and shouldn't be doing.

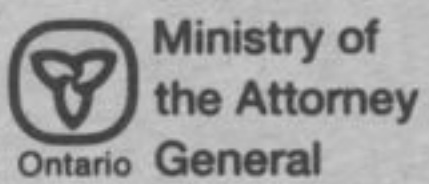

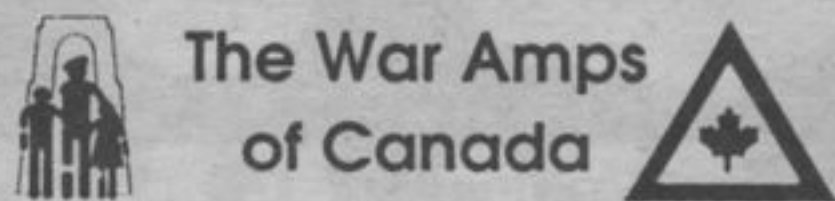
