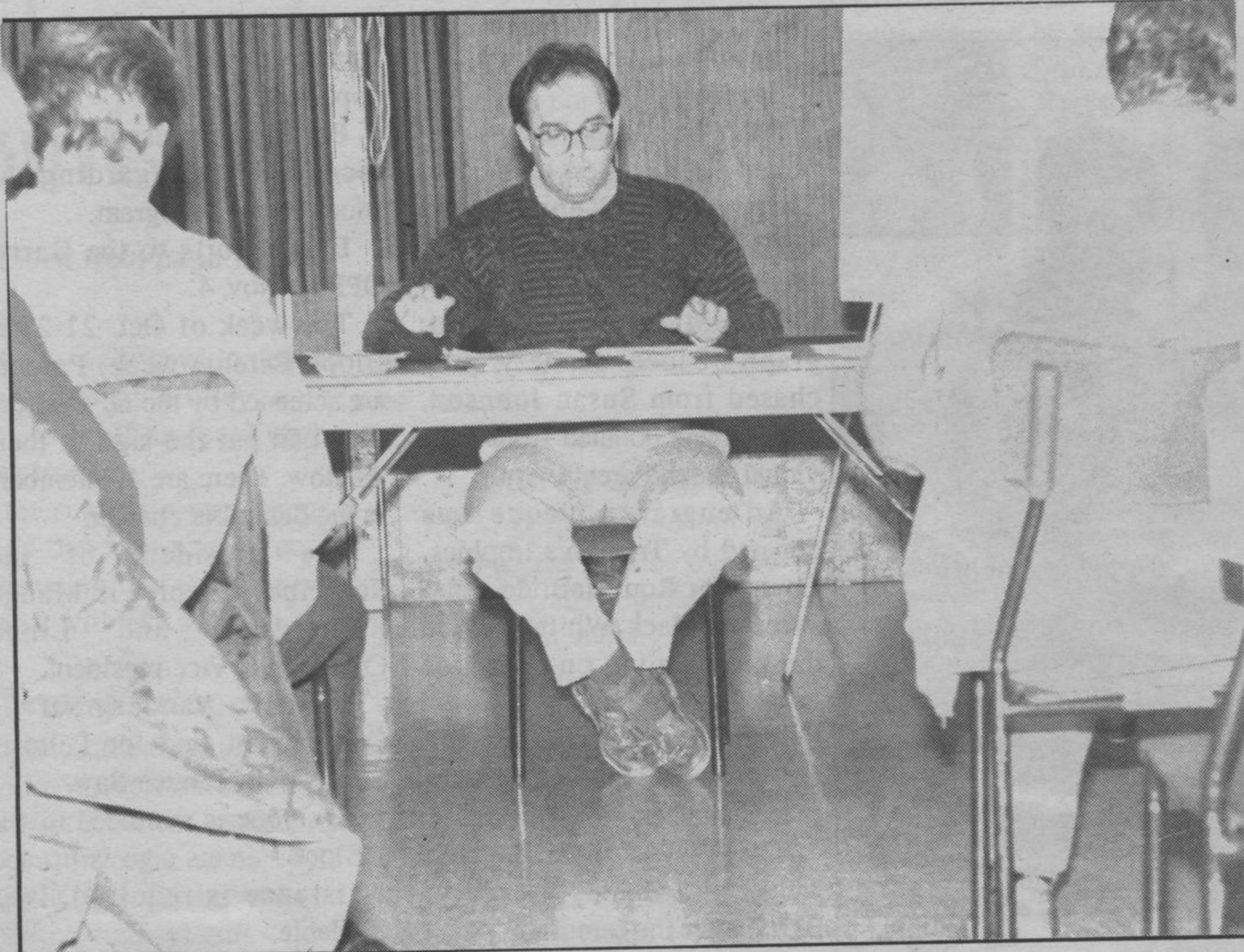


Small business week



Dan Friya addresses a crowd of about 15 people gathered at the Schreiber Recreation Centre last Thursday.

Friya, who works for the Federal Business Development Bank, offered tips on how to get a loan from his institution.

"We're mandated to do things the chartered banks don't do," he said.

"But just because we're a lender of last resort, doesn't mean we'll lend to anybody."

Friya outlined the criteria upon which the bank makes its lending decisions. They include management history, marketing and operations, earnings forecasts, collateral, individual investment, and impact on the environment.

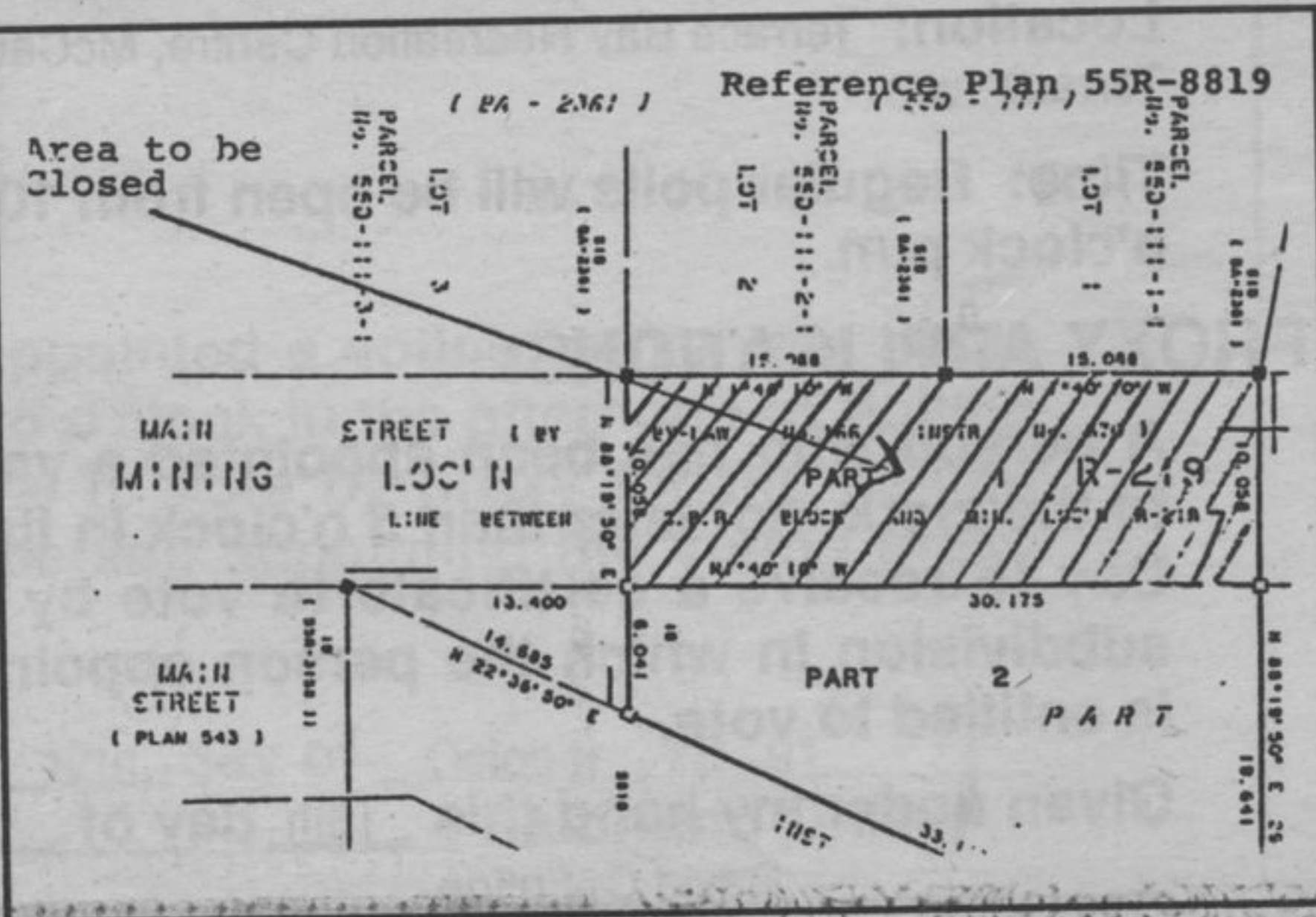
A By-Law to stop and close the public street or highway more particularly described as follows:

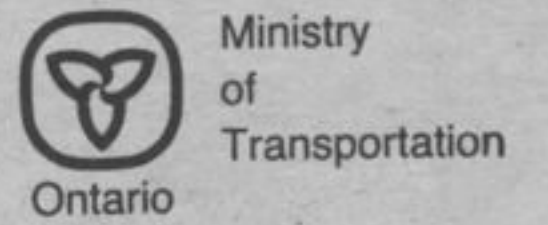
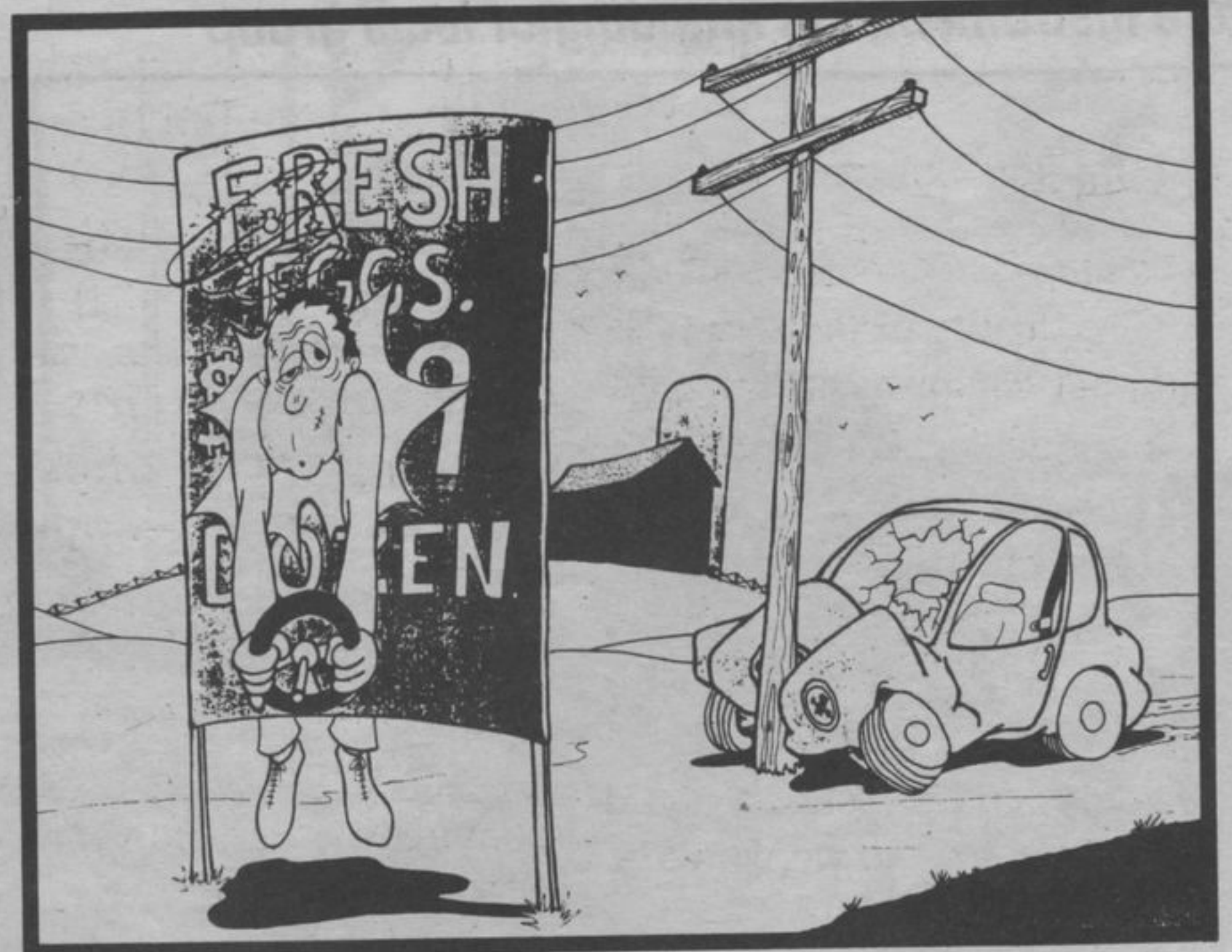
