MacKenzie new principal

The Lake Superior Board of Education has appointed Sharon MacKenzie principal of Lake Superior High School.

MacKenzie, who's currently the Vice-principal at LSHS, was appointed during the Board's regular meeting in Marathon Dec. 10.

The appointment is temporary, and takes effect Jan. 1. The Board will select a permanent replacement next fall.

A replacement for MacKenzie will be made at a later date.

MacKenzie replaces outgoing principal Balan Menon, whose probationary contract was not made permanent by the board.

Menon has filed a grievance as a result of that decision.

Winter driving tips

Thousands of Ontario motorists will be travelling greater distances during the Christmas-New Year's period, as they visit family and friends. To insure a safe trip, the Ontario Provincial Police is recommending motorists carry several important items with them.

To prevent a rear-wheel-drive car from becoming stuck in the snow, a bag of sand could be placed in the trunk to improve traction. To help free a stuck vehicle, sand, rock-salt, kitty litter or ashes, from a container in the trunk, could be sprinkled in the front of the drive wheels to allow the tires to grip the surface.

A piece of carpet or a car floor mat could also be used to keep the tires from spinning in the snow or on ice.

Other cold weather travel aids can be found around the home. They include a blanket, an old jacket, gloves, matches and an empty coffee can.
