do the kind of underwater blasting necessary to remove the shoal.

"It's just so we don't get

swamped with bids and have someone, not knowing the type

of work, come in with a bid that's half of another guy who

knows what he's doing. Then how do you justify not giving it to the lower bid?"

Earlier studies estimated the cost of removing the shoal in the neighbourhood of \$100,000, said Terrace Bay Clerk-Treasurer David Fulton.

Fulton also said that the Ministry of Northern Development and Mines has agreed to a

75 per cent grant to help cover the cost of removing the shoal.

"As long as the total costs don't go over \$100,000," the ministry will cover 75 per cent of the costs, he said.

Ray Mikkonen said he expects the project to be completed in February or, at the latest, in early March.

"It's not that big a job," he said.
