> Earlier studies estimated the cost of removing the shoal in neighbourhood \$100,000, said Terrace Bay Clerk-Treasurer David Fulton.

Fulton also said that the Ministry of Northern Develop-

ment and Mines has agreed to a

75 per cent grant to help cover the cost of removing the shoal.

"As long as the total costs don't go over \$100,000," the ministry will cover 75 per cent of the costs, he said.




