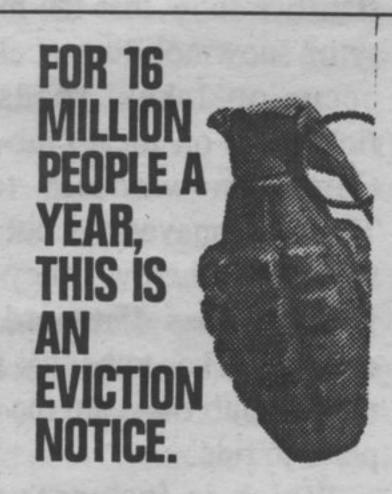
## A very successful venture

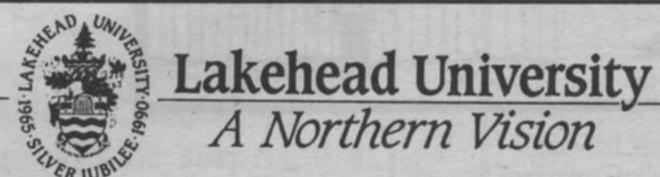
