The North Shore Sharks took home ringette bronze in the provincial playdowns held in Thunder Bay March 25-29.

Playing in the tweens divi-

sion, which are girls between the ages of 12-13, the Sharks finished second in the round robin part of the tournament. They led all seven teams in their division in scoring.

"We have been fundraising since January for this," said Sharks coach Sherri Jowitt. "And a lot of the players gave up their March break to practice for the championships."

On Sunday, the Sharks lost a very tight match to Thunder Bay. After having defeated the Thunder Bay team 10-7 in the round robin, they lost 9-8 Sunday to win the bronze medal.

This is only the team's second year, and they are the first local team ever to take home a medal at the provincial championships.

The team is made up of six players from Terrace Bay, one from Schreiber, six from Longlac and one from Geraldton.

They played against 35 teams from across the province, from places like Waterloo, Oshawa and Thunder Bay.

This was the first time the finals have been held in Northern Ontario.


