and space science. They were also judged on their ability to use and integrate scientific information with technology.

"The integration of science is how science is used in everyday life," says Lake.

"In other word, problem solving using science. The application of science refers to use of science through technology."

On the provincial level, LSBE students came first or second in every category except life science, in which they were third, behind

Saskatchewan and Alberta.

LSBE students received 69 per cent in life sciences; 71 per cent in physical science; 73 per cent in earth and space science; 83 per cent in nature of science; 74 per cent in knows; 71 per cent in uses; and 76 per cent in integrates.

Those scores are better than the average results in Ontario, Canada and in the other countries that were tested.

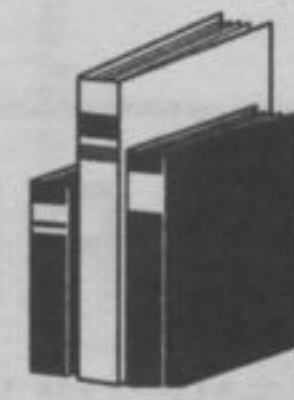

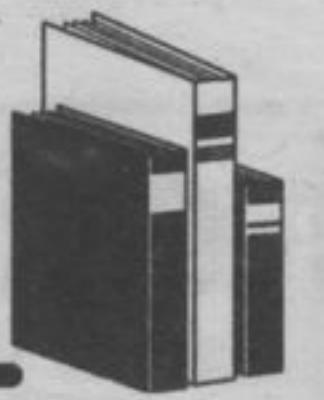

Spring Yard Cleanup Assistance Program

For the upcoming Spring season, the municipality will be offering yard cleanup services to the eligible families, which are defined as an individual, a couple, or a group of individuals living as a family unit. To qualify for the program, a family must:

1. Contain at least one individual over the age of 65 years; or who is handicapped;
- and
2. Not contain any person physically capable of performing the cleanup which is to be supplied under this program;
- and
3. Be the sole occupant group of the dwelling unit served by the property to be cleaned under the program;
- and
4. Have an application completed by an individual within the family unit stating that he/she/they are financially unable to make arrangements for yard cleanup by any other means.

Properties serving commercial properties or multiple dwellings will not be cleaned under this program.

Application forms are available at the Municipal Office, 12 Simcoe Plaza.
