MNR to expand partnerships

The Terrace Bay District Market Analysis Study, carried out by Lehman and Associates Consultants last year, gives very good marks to Ministry of Natural Resource's efforts at client services, but it also indicates the MNR should refocus more effort on direct consultation and partnerships with the public of Terrace Bay District.

The survey was completed following an analysis of mail sample questionnaires to various public clients of MNR, and analysis of open houses held in the communities contained in the Terrace Bay District by Lehman and Associ-

ates. This refocusing will see an increase in co-management and advisory groups made up of public representatives. It will also see a refocusing of some MNR office procedures, such as moving fishing and hunting licence issuance to more accessible public outlets with longer hours of service.

The MNR office in Terrace Bay will continue, however, to issue particular resource licences, fuelwood permits, work permits, trapping and commercial fish licences from MNR offices.

Other changes will also occur. For example, the

way, he said.

Another problem is the two bridges in town. Neither were built to accommodate pedestrians.

"What we would suggest would be for the municipality to deal with the MTO (Ministry of Transportation of Ontario), so that any future improvements to the bridges could accept pedestrian movements," he said.

Costs of extending the walkways are estimated at \$115,000, Moore said.

Moore/George's plans also include provisions to "diversify" the plant life along the cor-

ridor.

"It's pretty attractive scenery when you drive through Terrace Bay, but it's also pretty much all the same kind of trees" Moore said.

"The concern is, you're vulnerable. If something were to happen to the trees, visually, you would have quite a different atmosphere when you drove through town."

The plans include a \$60,000 program for landscaping and gradually diversifying the local plant life.

There are also plans for a pedestrian lighting system along the walkway, at a cost of \$225,000.

"But not every municipality puts in lighting," Moore said. "It's fairly expensive, and there's a question of whether or not it's really necessary."

Plans for Centennial park including the construction of a two-tiered retaining wall, a water feature, and some landscaping, perhaps in the form of a perennial flower garden.

"What we would be creating is a new central pedestrian plaza area," Moore said.

Estimated cost of the park improvements are estimated at \$425,000.

Moore also had proposals for a new signage system, including designs for arrival, directional and landmark signs, which would cost around \$10,000 each.
