# Former Terrace Bay constable guilty of assault

Former Terrace Bay Police Services Constable Glen Krentz has been sentenced to a \$600 fine or 30 days in jail after pleading guilty April 27 assaulting an 11year-old girl.

The plea is the result of an incident which occurred in

Krentz's lawyer, Lee Baig, declined to comment on whether or not he thought the sentence was light.

In a telephone interview Friday afternoon, Baig did say that in his opinion, a probationary sentence wasn't need-
